THE WINGSPAN PLAYERS: Musical Theatre

Incoming 6th-8th graders

5 weeks: July 2nd - August 4th 9-4:30 Mon-Thurs / 9-1 Fri

We believe that the best way for young artists to learn theatre is by combining class work and production; mornings of rehearsal are followed by afternoons full of acting, voice, dance and other performing arts Master Classes.

In production: Students will rehearse and perform a full classic musical theatre piece.

THE WINGSPAN ENSEMBLE: Theatre

Incoming 9th-12th graders

6 weeks: July 2nd - August 12th 10-5 Mon-Thurs / 10-1 Fri

The Wingspan Ensemble is a select group of high school students who love theatre and look forward to exploring meatier, more challenging work. Ensemble classes are more specialized and challenging than those offered to the Wingspan Players.

The goal of the Ensemble is to stretch our actors to create exciting work.

In production: Theatre students focus on less frequently produced plays and musicals.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS:

All students must return an application form as well as a teacher recommendation to the Wingspan Arts offices. Students should prepare 1 song and 1 minute-long monologue for the audition.

AUDITIONS WILL TAKE PLACE THE WEEKEND OF FEBRUARY 11, 2012
