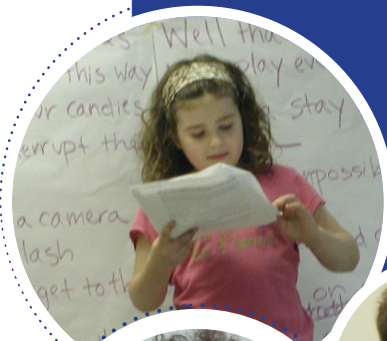

The Wingspan Gypsies are an amazing group of young students. In this innovative summer program children will create an original musical theatre piece. Wingspan Gypsies focus on creativity and the nurturing of children's inherent acting and writing skills. Students will learn the fundamentals of musical theatre: playmaking, acting, singing, and dancing using imagination games as well as formal classes. A creative drama program at heart, our gypsies are also stretched to expand their writing and musical horizons. Each day students are taken on a journey through all of these skills with multiple professionals in those fields.

Our staff consists of professional teaching artists with years of experience working with students of this age, as well as interns in arts and arts education - all college level or above.

Students will also have a chance to play outdoors every day. Come join the fun!

A Typical Day for a Gypsy

Morning/ Each morning students will have two periods of either playwriting or songwriting where they will create original material for their play

Noon/ Lunch

Early afternoon/ Afternoons are spent on honing performance skills, whether it is acting, singing, dancing or a "special" in another art form that will be highlighted in their play

Afternoon/ Snack and park time

Late afternoon/ Rehearsing the show as well as arts & crafts projects to build sets, props, and costumes

Session 1 students will create a fully original student driven piece; Session 2 uses some previously published materials as a jumping off point. Many students attend both sessions.

Wingspan Arts Terms and Conditions For participation in Conservatory Programming

I understand and agree:

- 1) That this payment is for Conservatory Programming and that I shall not be entitled to any deduction for my child's absences or illnesses during the term; that in the event of my child's withdrawal or suspension (see item #3 below) from the Program after classes have started, I shall not be entitled to any refund of unused tuition;
- 2) Partial tuition refunds considered if requested in writing before the beginning of the term. (Registration and materials fees are non-refundable.) All refund requests are evaluated on a case-by-case basis. If granted, refund will be processed in 4-6 weeks;
- 3) That the Program requires my child to meet certain standards of behavior and that if my child fails to behave or demonstrates repeated unsatisfactory conduct, the Program has the right to dismiss my child from the Program;
- 4) That Wingspan Arts reserves the right to change instructors and room assignments as necessary, or to cancel classes not meeting minimum enrollments;
- 5) That if my child is not picked up by the end of class, I agree to pay lateness fees according to Program policy; and that my child, in accordance with Department of Education policy, may be taken to the local Police Precinct in the event no one is available to supervise my child after class;
- 6) That if my child is injured and requires medical attention and I cannot be reached for instructions, I do hereby give authority to Wingspan Arts to obtain necessary emergency medical treatment for my child with the understanding that the family will be notified as soon as possible;
- 7) That during the Wingspan Arts Conservatory program, my child may be photographed and/or videotaped by Wingspan Arts personnel or its authorized agents exclusively for internal and/or promotional use;
- 8) That some Program classes may involve trips outside the building supervised by staff of the Program. I give my child permission to go on any such trips organized as part of the Program, including (but not limited to) neighborhood libraries, parks, museums, and other schools;
- 9) That in consideration of conducting the Wingspan Arts Conservatory Program and allowing my child to participate in such program, I hereby release and forever discharge Wingspan Arts, Inc., and its officers, volunteers, employees, contractors, and agents from any liability arising out of or based upon any bodily injury or property damage which may be sustained by my child while participating in such program.
