Daily Schedule

- Dismissal from school classrooms, snack and homework time are provided in the cafeteria.

Pickup ends at 6 PM sharp: Fees will be charged for late pickups.

Fees

All fees are non-refundable; Fees cover materials, insurance and other additional expenses when applicable.

- Registration fee (until Jan. 27) \$30
- Late Registration fee (after Jan. 27) \$40
- Payment Plan fee \$40
- Returned Check fee \$25
- Late pickup fee (6PM or later) \$1/minute*
**This price will increase with continued lateness.*

Club Wingspan tuition and fees may be an eligible expense through your dependant care spending account.

Online Payment Options

- **Full payment:** Due at registration for both full and reduced tuition. Online system accepts Visa, MasterCard and e-checks.
- **Payment Plan:** Made up of 4 installments; the first is paid when you register.
 - 1st – Paid at registration
 - 2nd – February 15
 - 3rd – March 15
 - 4th – April 15
- *Partial tuition refunds will be considered if requested in writing before the beginning of the term. Refund requests are evaluated on a case-by-case basis. If granted, refunds will be processed in 4-6 weeks. Registration fees and other additional fees are non-refundable.*

YCS SPRING 2012 CLASS DESCRIPTIONS



KINDERGARTEN – 1st GRADE CLASSES

Cartooning - Monday

Ever wanted Wiley Coyote to catch the Road Runner? Ever thought of a new cartoon character? In this class, anything is possible as you learn and develop skills in drawing and creating cartoons. Watch your preliminary sketches turn into colorful characters as you create your own comic strip!

Backyard Sports - Monday

A high-energy class filled with relays, ball games, and circle activities. We will learn new and exciting games to involve everyone in a full kinetic experience. Be prepared to improvise and develop your own games on the spot!

Cooking Up A Healthy Story - Tuesday - \$15 materials fee

Come and join us for a story, but listen very carefully. Can you guess the secret ingredient hidden in the book? Each story we read will give you a hint about the cooking activity that day. We will be read books and make treats, some to eat and some to play with. Each child will practice measuring, pouring, mixing and baking. When the club is over, we will have our own cookbook and even a tasting for grown-ups. So join us for a cooking class—the healthier the better!

Jr. Theatrix - Tuesday

Working together as an *ensemble*, we will create our own play or musical based on a book, picture, or poem. Students will experience different elements of theatre making through dramatic activities and creative play. By working in character, and within a set of imaginary circumstances, students develop theatrical improvisation skills as they story-build their final production for all to see!

Yogamotion - Wednesday

Breathe Deep. Meditate. Stretch. Move! Through the ancient art of yoga, students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. They will have the ability to find balance and focus that will help them throughout the school year. Ahhhhhh.....

Eco -Art – Wednesday

In this class we will learn how to reduce, reuse and reinvent! Projects will not only center on using both found objects and recycled materials, but will also include some units focused on natural materials. These might include a paper-making unit, recycled textile bags and/or woven crafts.

Dance Around the World - Thursday

In this class, dancers will learn styles such as African, Jazz, Ballet, Salsa, Afro-Caribbean, Indian, Hip Hop, Funk and Swing. They will dance to music from all over the world and play games that help them listen to the sounds that make each style and culture unique. This class helps open young children to the awareness of other countries historical dance styles and find a common colorful thread that runs through all movement.
