


# Fall 2018 Afterschool Schedule

### About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 130, and work in partnership with PS 130 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

### A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan’s central meeting area at PS 130.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM.
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00PM.
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00PM. Students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00PM. A fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6:00PM; fee increases after third late pick-up.

### Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

### Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. ### Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

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# **Class Descriptions**

## **Fall 2018**

### **MONDAY**

#### **Grades 2 & 3 – Actor's Workshop**

Calling all actors! In Actor's Workshop, we will learn key elements of theatre performance and rehearse speaking in front of an audience. We will hone individual skills and collaborate in ensemble work such as play building and scene study.

#### **Grades 3 & 4 – 3D Artists**

Let's build! This class is a 3D visual arts class with an emphasis on creativity, fun and invention! Students will learn sculpture - clay, foam, paper, wire; carving - linoleum, potatoes, soap; 3D printing; mobile and collage. Art lessons will be based on technique, craft media, and art history. Whatever the students make will be a unique expression of their creativity.

#### **Grades 4 & 5 – Jazz Dance**

Dancers in this class will learn the basic principles of jazz dance. They'll be grooving to syncopated rhythms, stepping, leaping, kicking, and perfecting those isolations before they know it. So come and get down with the Wingspan Arts Jazz Dancers!

## **Fall 2018**

### **TUESDAY**

#### **Grades 2 & 3 – Global Dance**

In this class, dancers will learn styles such as African, jazz, ballet, salsa, Afro-Caribbean, Indian, hip hop, funk and swing. They will dance to music from all over the world and play games that will help them listen to the sounds that make each style and culture unique. This class encourages an awareness and appreciation of other countries' historical dance styles and inspires students to find a common colorful thread that runs through ALL movement.

#### **Grades 3 & 4 – Myths & Legends**

What do the Loch Ness Monster, Big Foot, and Paul Bunyan have in common? Well, in Myths & Legends, all their stories will come alive! In this creative class, students will be introduced to drama and theatre through the use of timeless myths and legends. As a final presentation they will stage their very own adaptation or perhaps even create their own story!

#### **Grades 4 & 5 – LEGO: Stop Motion \$15 Materials Fee**

This isn't your average LEGO class! *Build. Snap! Move. Snap! Move. Snap! Move. Snap!* Using Stop Motion software, students will build LEGO creations and bring them to life on the screen. These LEGO creators will need to master the skills of teamwork, patience, observation, creative thinking, and problem solving in order to create these LEGO mini-movies.

### **WEDNESDAY**

#### **Grades 2 & 3 – Eco Art**

In this class, we will learn how to reduce, reuse, and reinvent! Projects will not only center on using both found objects and recycled materials, but also on utilizing natural materials. Find out not only how to save the earth, but make it beautiful!

#### **Grades 3 & 4 – Dance Studio**

The essence of this class is the joy of expression through different forms of dance. The young dancer will experience such dance styles as tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, just to name a few. So, sway on over to this class if you're interested in learning a variety of dance and creative movement styles!

#### **Grades 4 & 5 – Sketch Comedy**

If you like to crack up your friends and family, then this is the class for you. Build up your skills by learning the fundamentals of performing for an audience and making them laugh. This class involves improvisation technique, props, costumes, and character development. Master the art of funny!

### THURSDAY

#### **Grade 2 & 3 – Lego Architects** *\$15 Materials Fee*


In this class, students experience the excitement of Lego and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all while students use their imaginations to build the most amazing creations! We will learn about famous pieces of art and architecture, explore 2D mosaics, and build upwards in 3D. Students will be able to build individually and in groups, giving them a sense of ensemble and how their pieces and fun ideas fit into the whole.

#### **Grades 3 & 4 – Fresh Foodies** *\$25 Materials Fee*

In this class, students will not only learn about seasonal fruits and vegetables, but also how to prepare them in fun and creative ways! Each class will end with a healthy, local, and delicious snack made by the students! By the end of the semester, they will have a book of recipes and happy tummies! Creative, nutritious, and delicious!

#### **Grades 4 & 5 Pop Choir**

Is music in your soul? Then sing it! Work those vocal chords and see what it takes to be part of a chorus through learning and performing contemporary pop songs! Singers will explore harmonies, melodies, and the vocal techniques to sing songs in a whole new way.

## **Fall 2018**

### **FRIDAY**

#### **Grades 2 & 3 – Chess**

Playing chess promotes intellectual growth and improves students' academic performance. Through learning how to play chess, students learn strategic thinking and the value of planning ahead, patience, perseverance and determination. In this course, students who are new to the game of chess will learn how to coordinate pieces to attack and defend, how to castle, and how to checkmate their opponents. Students will also be introduced to chess tactics (including the pin, fork, and skewer), as well as basic checkmating patterns. Each semester will culminate with an in-class chess tournament, complete with prizes and trophies, through which students will be able to put into practice all they have learned.

#### **Grades 3 & 4 – Mini-Musical**

"5, 6, 7, 8!" Get ready for a song and dance experience like you have never had before. This class will explore musical theatre, dance and music – and give you the chance to do it yourself! Not only will you get to work on your turns and time-steps, but you will also work on creating your own original show!

#### **Grades 4 & 5 – Studio Art**

This class is designed for students who want to develop and hone their artistic vision. Surrounded by other young sculptors, painters, or illustrators – we will work toward an understanding of each artist's voice. This class is for young artists who want to experiment and develop skills with new and familiar mediums!
