Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 183, and work in partnership with PS 183 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan's central meeting area at PS 183.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM.
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 5:00PM.
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 6:00PM; Students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00PM. A fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6:00PM; fee increases after third late pick-up.

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Class Descriptions Fall 2018

MONDAY

Grades Pre-K & K – Yogamotion

Breathe deeply. Meditate. Stretch. Move! Through the ancient art of yoga, students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. These yoga sessions will combine emotional reflection, light stretching, breathing, various yoga poses, and meditation. Students will learn downward facing dog, upward facing dog, child's pose, windmill pose, frog pose, tortoise pose and more!

Grades K-1 – Actor's Playground

Have you ever wondered why they call it a play? Because acting is fun! In this play-based drama class, students will experiment with improvisation, ensemble-building, and acting exercises to discover the joy of theatre. All the world's a stage (or a playground) in this energetic and active thespian experience.

Grades 1-3 – 3D Art

Let's build! This class is a 3D visual arts class with an emphasis on creativity, fun, and invention! Students will learn sculpture methods using clay, foam, wire, and more. Through pottery, ceramics, statues, and abstract sculpture - students will learn the different techniques necessary to become a true 3D Artist.

Grades 2-4 – Percussion

Express yourself, feel the beat, and let the rhythm take you to new discoveries in this class. Students will learn percussion techniques, how to create different tones and learn a wide range of rhythms. The term will culminate in a final music performance featuring the student ensemble in a percussion jam.

Grades 3-5 – Animation with Sh!ne \$60 Materials Fee

In Animation, students will have the opportunity to create their own stop motion animation shorts both individually and as a group. They will learn about storyboards, script writing and editing in addition to getting the chance to create their own characters, backgrounds and stories for their films! At the end of the class, students will have practiced all of the jobs required to create a stop motion animation piece and will have created a short film.

TUESDAY

Grades Pre-K & K – Music Makers

Through songs, games, and exercises, we'll explore the fundamentals of music. We'll learn about dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm. In the course of our time together we will write our own songs and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary.

Grades K-2 – Painter's Palette

Create sketch drawings and turn them into beautiful paintings using a variety of paints and canvases! Learn how to use color and value to create light, shadows, and form. Explore composition, color mixing, painting techniques, and self-expression in this fun class!

For students who are **advanced yellow belt and above**

Students will spend an extra half hour each week perfecting the art of karate. Dedicated students train in kumite, advanced kata, meditation, and choreographed fight combinations.

KP for Kids is a professional karate afterschool program staffed with well-trained instructors that demonstrate respectful behavior in an active, physical, fun-loving environment. It is our philosophy that all children must be treated respectfully in order to emulate that behavior towards others. Additionally, children should have access to a safe, healthy, encouraging afterschool activity that will help develop not only their physical abilities but their mental focus and concentration. KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities.

Grades 3-5 – Sketch Comedy

If you like to crack up your friends and family, then this is the class for you. Build up your skills by learning the fundamentals of performing for an audience and making them laugh. This class involves improvisation technique, props, costumes, and character development. Master the art of funny!

WEDNESDAY

Grades Pre-K & K – Creature Creations

In this hands-on class, students will design their own creatures and then learn the basics of puppet making to make them come to life! There will be lots of brainstorming and building puppets from foam, cardboard, Styrofoam– even fruits and vegetables! Best of all, every student will get to take their creatures home.

Grades K-1 – Sing Me a Story

In this creative music class, young musicians express themselves by acting out stories and writing original songs. Through theatre games and improvisation, they'll learn some basic tools of scene writing and songwriting. After playing out a few well-known stories, they'll work together to create their own original story – and write their own all-original musical play! The young musicians will then rehearse the piece they have written and perform it in the Wingspan Arts showcase.

Grades 1-3 – Lego Artists \$15 Materials Fee

In this class, students experience the excitement of Lego and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all while students use their imaginations to build the most amazing creations! We will learn about famous pieces of art and architecture, explore 2D mosaics and build upwards in 3D. Students will be able to build individually and in groups, giving them a sense of ensemble and how their pieces and fun ideas fit into the whole.

Grades 2-4 – Filmmaking \$25 Materials Fee

Want to make a movie? While learning about the technical aspects of filmmaking and doing acting exercises, students will create characters, and write a script for their very own movie. Be an actor, writer, designer, and cinematographer! Students will leave with a digital copy of their work at the end of the semester.

Grades 3-5 – Global Art

Let's travel the world! From Italy to Japan, Egypt to Australia, we will explore art from across the globe. Students will paint, sculpt, and sketch their way through different folktales, celebrations, and traditions. We are going to bring the world to our classroom!

THURSDAY

Grades Pre-K & K – Myths & Legends

What do the Loch Ness Monster, Big Foot, and Paul Bunyan have in common? Well, in Myths & Legends, all their stories will come alive! In this creative class, students will be introduced to drama and theatre through the use of timeless myths and legends. As a final presentation they will stage their very own adaptation or perhaps even create their own story!

Grades K-1 – Eco Art

In this class we will learn how to reduce, reuse, and reinvent! Projects will not only center on using both found objects and recycled materials, but also on utilizing natural materials. Find out not only how to save the earth, but make it beautiful!

Grades 1-3 – Dance Studio

The essence of this class is the joy of expression through different forms of dance. The young dancer will experience such dance styles as tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, just to name a few. So, sway on over to this class if you're interested in learning a variety of dance and creative movement styles!

Grades 2-4 – DIY Publishing

Write your own book, create your own poster, publish a Wingspan Arts magazine in this exciting DIY Publishing class. Students will fuse their literary and creative talents with discussion on current events in media and the local community to create an array of artistic works. Students will write news articles, make stickers, and more in this publishing course!

Grades 3-5 – Super Scratch with Code Advantage \$60 Materials Fee

Scratch uses a graphic programming language developed at MIT. This class creates a beginner foundation in programming which can be used in other advanced programming languages. In Super Scratch, young students will learn fundamental programming concepts by creating different adventures using animations and story telling. Kids will program Scratch to do magic tricks, go on a treasure hunt, and even explore nature!

No previous programming skills are required, but students should be comfortable using a computer and managing files.

FRIDAY

Grades Pre-K & K – Dance Around the World

In this class, dancers will learn styles such as African, jazz, ballet, salsa, Afro-Caribbean, Indian, hip hop, funk and swing. They will dance to music from all over the world and play games that will help them listen to the sounds that make each style and culture unique. This class encourages an awareness and appreciation of other countries' historical dance styles and inspires students to find a common colorful thread that runs through ALL movement.

Grades K-1 – Cooking Creations with Allergic to Salad \$25 Materials Fee

Fun, hands-on, and from-scratch! Our classes create a platform for a lifetime of adventurous eating and purposeful life-skills. Classes focus on kitchen safety, knife skills and vegetable, fruit and equipment identification. All classes include basic STEM concepts within the cooking lessons. Kids will be cooking up-- and eating-- dishes like spanikopita, sushi, paratha, pumpkin ravioli and more!

Grades 1-3 – Athletic Adventures

Ready to get physical? In this class, students will explore different ways to stay active and have tons of fun! This class will include aspects of yoga, cardio-training, and various team sports as well as individual challenges. Activities will focus on advancing skills like balance, agility, strength, endurance and flexibility.

Grades 2-4 – Art of Science

In Art of Science, we explore science creatively by using our right brain and all of our senses. We'll taste the periodic table and discover the science of music. We'll explore the solar system, space and even dinosaurs through dance, theatre games and puppetry. We will paint, color and craft experiments that help us understand friction, force, chemical reactions and so much more! This class is perfect for the creative and the curious.

Grades 3-5 – Hip Hop

With a combination of old school and new school hip hop, you'll learn cutting edge street dance movements like popping, locking, hitting, jamming, electric boogaloo, break, and other urban dance moves. This class gives you a hip hop dance experience unlike any other.
