About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 281, and work in partnership with PS 281 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan's central meeting area at PS 281
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00 PM
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00 PM. A fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6 PM; fee increases after third late pick-up.

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their inability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

Class Descriptions

Fall 2017

Monday

Grades PreK & K – Culinary Creations with Allergic to Salad *\$25 Materials Fee*

Fun, hands-on, and from-scratch! Our classes create a platform for a lifetime of adventurous eating and purposeful life-skills. Classes focus on kitchen safety, knife skills, and vegetable, fruit, and equipment identification. All classes include basic STEM concepts within the cooking lessons. Kids will be cooking up-- and eating-- dishes like Spanikopita, Sushi, Paratha, Pumpkin Ravioli and more!

Grades K-1 – Superhero Theatre

Get your capes ready and imaginations in gear – no phone booth required! This class focuses on finding your inner superhero. Using imagination and creative play, students will develop characters that do great things and help people! At the end of the semester, students will share their superhero stories in an original performance.

Grade 1-3 – Yoga

Breathe deeply. Meditate. Stretch. Move! Through the ancient art of yoga, students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. They will have the ability to find balance and focus that will help them throughout the school year.

Grades 2-4 – Filmmaker’s Workshop *\$25 Materials Fee*

Want to make a movie? Take this class and learn how to use a state-of-the art digital video camera! Students will first watch commercials, documentaries, and short films by students, discussing the message behind the images. While doing improv acting exercises, students will create characters, and write a script around those characters. Be an actor, writer, designer, and cinematographer! Each child will leave with a copy of the movie.

Tuesday

Grades Pre-K & K – Legomania *\$15 Materials Fee*

Legos just got even more fun! In this class, students experience the excitement of Legos and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking and problem-solving skills all while encouraging the use of creativity and imagination to build the most amazing creations!

Grades K-1 – Dance Me A Story

Through music, movement, and various dance techniques, students will explore the world of storytelling. Using their bodies in creative and expressive ways, students will revisit classic stories and create new ones! These young dancers will build choreography and characters that will culminate in an original story set to music!

Grades 1-3 – 3D Art

Let's build! This club is a 3D visual arts class with an emphasis on creativity, fun, and invention! Students will learn sculpture - clay, foam, paper, wire; carving - linoleum, potatoes, soap; 3D printing; mobile and collage. Art lessons will be based on technique, craft media, and art history. Whatever the students will make will be a unique expression of their creativity.

Grades 2-4 – Global Artifacts & Games \$15 Materials Fee

Do you like going on journeys to the past through books, films, flea markets, and museums? Maybe Mr. Peabody and Sherman was a favorite movie and you are excited to delve into history more deeply! Join us on a continental journey from Africa to the Americas to Asia as we examine a host of objects, costumes, games, and more that offer insight into the lives and values of these cultures. Classes will engage in role-play, tablet activities, and meet with antiques specialists as we try to inhabit other worlds.

Wednesday

Grades PreK & K – Actor's Playground

Have you ever wondered why they call it a play? BECAUSE ACTING IS FUN! In this play-based drama class, students will experiment with improvisation, ensemble-building, and acting exercises to discover the joy of theatre. All the world's a stage (or a playground) in this energetic and active class.

Grades K-1 – Painter's Palette

Create sketch drawings and turn them into beautiful paintings using a variety of paints and canvases! Learn how to use color and value to create light, shadows, and form. Explore composition, color mixing, painting techniques, and self-expression in this fun class!

Grades 1-3 – Myths & Legends

What do the Loch Ness Monster, Big Foot, and Paul Bunyan have in common? Well, in Myths & Legends, all their stories will come alive! In this creative class, students will be introduced to drama and theatre through the use of timeless myths and legends. As a final presentation, they will stage their very own adaptation or perhaps even create their own story!

Grades 2-4 – Wearable Art \$15 Materials Fee

Whatever you make, you wear! Jewelry design will be the focus of this class, and kids will create necklaces, earrings, bracelets, friendship pins, and tattoos along the way. Watch out for an original T-shirt and hat here and there. Students can show off and sell their creations in a silent auction during the showcase.

Thursday

Grades Pre-K & K – Music to My Ears

Through songs, games, and exercises, we explore the fundamentals of music. We learn about dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm. We sing, we move, and we enjoy listening to music that ranges from Tchaikovsky to Frank Sinatra, and even some of Broadway's top hits! In the course of our time together, each student will develop proper singing techniques and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary.

Grades K-1 – Destination Mars with LAUNCH \$60 Materials Fee

Join our flight crew as we blast off to Mars! This exciting class is all about rockets and how they are fueling our knowledge of other worlds. Mission preparation includes building mini-launch vehicles and conducting experiments to explore the science behind space travel. From the basics of Newton's Laws to solid and liquid propellants, students learn what it takes to be a real rocket scientist! The journey continues with a touchdown on the red planet where we establish a colony, build a rover, and orbit a satellite to explore the Martian landscape. It's sure to be an experience that's out of this world!

Grades 1-3 – Ballet

For beginners and experienced dancers alike, learn the basics of ballet, including stretching, and dance vocabulary. Each class includes a mini-performance and creative dance games to fire up the imagination. Taught with lots of encouragement and gentle guidance, this is the perfect class for budding prima ballerinas! *Movement clothes required.*

Grades 2-4 – Studio Art: Drawing & Painting

Create sketch drawings and turn them into beautiful paintings using a variety of paints and canvases! Learn how to use color and value to create light, shadows, and form. Explore composition, color mixing, painting techniques, and self-expression in this fun class!

Friday

Grades PreK & K – Dance Through the Decades

From Scott Joplin's ragtime at the turn of the century to flappers in the Roarin' 20s; from Glenn Miller and the Big Band Swing to the Twist and Mashed Potato; from the 70s Hustle to Hip Hop, we will explore the growth of dance and music over the past century in America. We will learn multiple dance styles, and view film and other media to show how music and dance have changed over time, and the effect these arts have had on American culture.

Grades K-1 – Art Safari

Discover the world of art with a Wingspan Arts Teaching Artist as your guide! We will explore art from across the globe. Through different folktales, celebrations, and traditions, we are going to bring the world to our classroom. Students will gain experience in drawing and painting as well as mixed media and sculpture. This is a great class in which to explore a variety of artistic mediums and explore art styles from around the world!

Grades 1-4 – Broadway Bound

“5, 6, 7, 8!” Get ready for a song and dance experience like never before. This class will explore musical theatre, dance, and music – and give students the chance to do it themselves! Students will master the essentials in acting, and leave the class ready to become a Broadway star!

Students will spend an extra half hour each week perfecting the art of karate. Dedicated students train in kumite, advanced kata, meditation, and choreographed fight combinations.

KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities.
