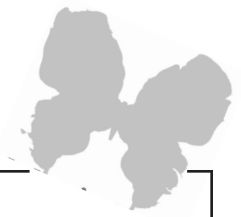

### About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 303, and work in partnership with PS 303 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

### A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan’s central meeting area at PS 303
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM Monday-Thursday and 3:00PM on Fridays
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00PM Monday-Thursday and 3:00-4:30PM on Fridays.
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00PM Monday-Thursday and 4:40-6:00PM on Fridays; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00PM; a fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6:00PM; Fee increases after third late pick-up.

### Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

### Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. ### Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

# **Class Descriptions**

## **Fall 2018**

### **MONDAY**

#### **Grade Pre-K – Fairytale Theatre**

Fairies and goblins and elves, oh my! Combine storytelling with theatre and let your imagination soar in this creative drama class. Young artists will explore classic fairytales and bring them to the stage each week; they might even create a few of their own and bring new characters to life! This is the perfect class for aspiring actors, playwrights, and everyone who loves the magic and mystery of fairytales.

#### **Grades K-1 – Dance Studio**

The essence of this class is the joy of expression through different forms of dance. The young dancer will experience such dance styles as tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, just to name a few. So, sway on over to this class if you're interested in learning a variety of dance and creative movement styles!

#### **Grades K-1 – Eco Art**

In this class we will learn how to reduce, reuse, and reinvent! Projects will not only center on using both found objects and recycled materials, but also on utilizing natural materials. These might include a paper-making unit, recycled textile bags, and/or woven crafts. We will also experiment with plant-based inks and twig bookbinding.

#### **Grades 2-3 – Pop Choir**

Is music in your soul? Then sing it! Work those vocal chords and see what it takes to be part of a chorus through learning and performing contemporary pop songs! Singers will explore harmonies, melodies, and the vocal techniques to sing songs in a whole new way.

#### **Grades 2-3 – Art Studio: Drawing & Painting**

Van Gogh, Picasso, and Monet are only some of the names students will learn in this exciting hands-on class. Through the introduction of several painting techniques, students will learn about image composition, drawing, shadows, and light. With a variety of methods, students will learn about art history and also create their own pieces. Students will hone their fine motor skills and enjoy working with watercolor, acrylic, and pastels in this exciting art studio class.



# **Class Descriptions**

## **Fall 2018**

### **TUESDAY**

#### **Grade Pre-K – Art Safari**

Discover the world of art with a Wingspan Arts Teaching Artist as your guide! We will explore art from across the globe. Through different folktales, celebrations, and traditions, we are going to bring the world to our classroom. Students will gain experience in drawing and painting as well as mixed media and sculpture. This is a great class in which to explore a variety of artistic mediums and art styles from around the world!

#### **Grades K-1 – Myths & Legends**

What do the Loch Ness Monster, Big Foot, and Paul Bunyan have in common? Well, in Myths & Legends, all their stories will come alive! In this creative class, students will be introduced to drama and theatre through the use of timeless myths and legends. As a final presentation they will stage their very own adaptation or perhaps even create their own story!

#### **Grades K-1 – Lego Artists \$15 Materials Fee**

In this class, students experience the excitement of Lego and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all while students use their imaginations to build the most amazing creations! We will learn about famous pieces of art and architecture, explore 2D mosaics, and build upwards in 3D. Students will be able to build individually and in groups, giving them a sense of ensemble and how their pieces and fun ideas fit into the whole.

#### **Grades 2-3 – Yoga**

Yoga is a great way to maintain fitness and health. It is a form of exercise connecting the body and mind through poses, breathing control, and meditation. These yoga sessions will combine emotional reflection, light stretching, breathing, various yoga poses, and meditation. Students will learn downward facing dog, upward facing dog, child's pose, windmill pose, frog pose, tortoise pose, and more.

#### **Grades 2-3 – Broadway Bound**

This class is for our future Broadway stars. Actors will learn what it takes to put together a show from start to finish, complete with acting, singing and dancing. For those who are interested in learning more about musical theatre, this class will cover everything an actor needs to know to become Broadway bound!

### WEDNESDAY

#### **Grade Pre-K – Movin' & Groovin'**

This high-energy class combines rhythm and dance to get everyone movin' to the beat! We will explore different dance and movement styles through a wide-range of fun music, imaginative games, and exercises. In this class you will certainly have fun finding new ways to move to the groove!

#### **Grades K-1 – Circus Arts**

This class is going to have you bouncing off the walls...literally! With our clowning and tumbling instructor, students will learn the basics of clowning like you see in circuses! We will also explore the world of tumbling and gymnastics, and team-building activities to culminate in one crazy adventure!

#### **Grades K-1 – Music Makers with Music to Your Home *\$15 Materials Fee***

Through songs, games, and exercises, we'll explore the fundamentals of music. We'll learn about dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm. In the course of our time together we will write our own songs and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary.

#### **Grades 2-3 – Playwriting & Performance**

Join playwriting and bring your stories to the stage! In this class, students will discover the excitement of playwriting as they bring plot, character, theme and more to life in the limelight. After an introduction to the basics of dramatic theory and the playwriting process, students will have the opportunity to write and perform their own theatrical masterpiece!

#### **Grades 2-3 –World Cooking *\$25 Materials Fee***

Take a culinary tour around the world! In this class, we will cook our way around the world and while we are at it, learn about the history and culture of the different places we "visit!"

### THURSDAY

#### **Grade Pre-K – Yogamotion**

Breathe deeply. Meditate. Stretch. Move! Through the ancient art of yoga, students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. They will have the ability to find balance and focus that will help them throughout the school year.



# **Class Descriptions**

## **Fall 2018**

### **Grades K-1 – Mini Musical**

“5, 6, 7, 8!” Get ready for a song and dance experience like you have never had before. This class will explore musical theatre, dance, and music – and give you the chance to do it yourself! Not only will you get to work on your turns and time-steps, but you will also work on creating your own original show!

### **Grades K-1 – Puzzles & Games *\$15 Materials Fee***

This class will “Boggle” your mind! Learn from the classics, by playing games like Monopoly and chess. Then create your own board games, treasure maps, puzzles, and mazes. You won't be “Sorry” you signed up for this class.

### **Grades 2-3 – Mixed Media Arts**

Geared toward fine art and sculpture, Mixed Media Arts emphasizes creativity, invention, and fun! Projects include sculpture (clay, foam, paper, wire); carving (linoleum, potatoes, soap); mobile and collage. Each week, students will learn about a famous artist while studying technique, craft media and art history. Using this knowledge, students will then create projects inspired by these artists.

### **Grades 2-3 – Improv Workshop**

Have you ever wanted to try acting? Or create characters and tell stories with in-the-moment inspiration? Then Improv Workshop is for you! This class will include readings of well-known stories, and students will use humor and theatre games on this improvisational journey.

## **FRIDAY**

### **Grade Pre-K – Sing Me a Story**

In this creative music class, young musicians will express themselves by acting out stories and writing original songs. They will explore well-known stories and create their own through theatre and improvisation games. With these tools, they will learn to tell their own stories through song.

### **Grades K-1 – Modern Masters**

This class is for the artist and the art historian alike! In this class, students will learn about and discuss different art genres and periods, such as Impressionism, Fauvism, Pointillism, Art Nouveau, Art Deco, Pop Art, and abstract art. They will then create their own 2D and 3D artworks inspired by these ideas.



# **Class Descriptions**

## **Fall 2018**

### **Grades K-1 – Actor’s Playground**

Have you ever wondered why they call it a play? BECAUSE ACTING IS FUN! In this play-based drama class, students will experiment with improvisation, ensemble-building, and acting exercises to discover the joy of theatre. All the world’s a stage (or a playground) in this energetic and active class.

### **Grades 2-3 – Future Choreographers**

The essence of this class is the joy of expression through different forms of dance. The young dancer will experience dance styles such as jazz, ballet, hip hop, funk, and swing, to name a few. Students will use this knowledge of dance to generate their own choreography and explore new movement styles. This class is geared towards students who love dance and have experience taking dance classes through Wingspan Arts and beyond.

### **Grades 2-3 – DIY Publishing**

Write your own book, create your own poster, publish a Wingspan Arts magazine in this exciting DIY Publishing class. Students will fuse their literary and creative talents with discussion on current events in media and the local community to create an array of artistic works. Students will write news articles, make stickers, and more in this publishing class!
