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About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 303, and work in partnership with PS 303 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan’s central meeting area at PS 303.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM. Monday-Thursday and 3:00 PM on Fridays
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00 PM Monday-Thursday and 3:00-4:30 PM on Fridays.
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00 PM Monday-Thursday and 4:40-6:00 PM on Fridays; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00 PM. A fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6:00 PM; fee increases after third late pick-up.

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

Class Descriptions

MONDAY

Grade Pre-K – Dance Me a Story

Anyone can tell a story, but can you dance it? As the students learn fun dance steps, they will integrate their new moves into an exciting story...without words! Watch them skip, bop, and shimmy their way from “Once Upon a Time” to “Happily Ever After”!

Grades K-1 – Acting & Improv

Have you ever wanted to try acting? Or create characters and tell stories with in-the-moment inspiration? Then Acting & Improv is for you! This class will include readings of well-known stories, and students will play humor and theatre games on this improvisational journey.

Grades K-1 – Artist Books

Visualize your name on the spine or cover of a collectible handmade artist book. In this class, students will use tactile materials and a wide-array of artistic processes to create their own artistic works. Great ready to draw, paint, and cartoon!

Grades 2-3 – Songwriter’s Studio

Students will examine the craft of songwriting through the use of poetry, percussion, and singing. We will write songs as a group and individually, and each student will develop proper singing techniques and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary. Discover your creative genius and become a songwriting superstar!

Grades 2-3 – Art Studio: Drawing & Painting

Van Gogh, Picasso, and Monet are only some of the names students will learn in this exciting hands-on class. Through the introduction of several painting techniques, students will learn about image composition, drawing, shadows, and light. With a variety of methods, students will learn about art history and also create their own pieces. Students will hone their fine motor skills and enjoy working with watercolor, acrylic, and pastels in this exciting art studio class.

TUESDAY

Grade Pre-K – Music to My Ears

Through songs, games, and exercises, we’ll explore the fundamentals of music. We’ll learn about dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm. In the course of our time together we will write our own songs and sing some of our old favorites!

Grades K-1 – Mixed Media Arts

Geared toward fine art and sculpture, Mixed Media Arts emphasizes creativity, invention, and fun! Projects include sculpture (clay, foam, paper, wire); carving (linoleum, potatoes, soap); mobile and collage. Each week, students will learn about a famous artist while studying technique, craft media and art history. Using this knowledge, students will then craft projects inspired by these artists.

Grades K-1 – Cooking Creations with Allergic to Salad \$25 Materials Fee

Fun, hands-on, and from-scratch! Our classes create a platform for a lifetime of adventurous eating and purposeful life-skills. Classes focus on kitchen safety, knife skills and vegetable, fruit and equipment identification. All classes include basic STEM concepts within the cooking lessons. Kids will be cooking up-- and eating-- dishes like spanikopita, sushi, paratha, pumpkin ravioli and more!

Grades 2-3 – Lego Architects \$15 Materials Fee

In this class, students experience the excitement of Legos and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking and problem-solving skills all while students use their imaginations to build the most amazing creations! We will learn about famous pieces of art and architecture, explore 2D mosaics, and build upwards in 3D. Students will be able to build individually and in groups, giving them a sense of ensemble and how their pieces and fun ideas fit into the whole.

Grades 2-3 – Playwriting & Performance

Join playwriting and bring your stories to the stage! In this class, students will discover the excitement of playwriting as they bring plot, character, theme and more to life in the limelight. After an introduction to the basics of dramatic theory and the playwriting process, students will have the opportunity to write and perform their own theatrical masterpiece!

WEDNESDAY

Grade Pre-K – Painter's Palette

Create sketch drawings and turn them into beautiful paintings using a variety of paints and canvases! Learn how to use color and value to create light, shadow, and form. Explore composition, color mixing, painting techniques, and self-expression in this fun class!

Grades K-1 – Star Performers

Become your favorite pop star! From Taylor Swift to Bruno Mars, we will learn to sing and dance like these amazing pop stars - and even create our own performing personalities. Each week we will work on the vocal skills, dance moves, and personal style it takes to become a superstar!

Grades K-1 – Circus Arts

This class is going to have you bouncing off the walls...literally! With our clowning and tumbling instructor, kids will learn the basics of clowning as you see in circuses! We will also explore the world of tumbling and gymnastics and how to use team-building activities to culminate in one crazy adventure!

Grades 2-3 – Global Dance

In this class, dancers will learn styles such as African, jazz, ballet, salsa, Afro-Caribbean, Indian, hip hop, funk and swing. They will dance to music from all over the world and play games that help them listen to the sounds that make each style and culture unique. This class encourages an awareness and appreciation of other countries' historical dance styles and inspires students to find a common colorful thread that runs through ALL movement.

Grades 2-3 –World Cooking *\$25 Materials Fee*

Take a culinary tour around the world! In this class, we will cook our way around the world and while we are at it, learn about the history and culture of the different places we "visit"!

THURSDAY

Grade Pre-K – Yogamotion

Breathe deeply. Meditate. Stretch. Move! Through the ancient art of yoga, students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. They will have the ability to find balance and focus that will help them throughout the school year.

Grades K-1 – Lego Artists *\$15 Materials Fee*

In this class, students experience the excitement of Lego and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all while students use their imaginations to build the most amazing creations! We will learn about famous pieces of art and architecture, explore 2D mosaics, and build upwards in 3D. Grades K-1 – Mini-Mozart

In this class, we will explore classical music! We will listen to compositions from a variety of composers and learn about the history behind the piece. In the course of our time together we will write our own songs and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary.

Grades 2-3 – Eco-Art

In this class we will learn how to reduce, reuse, and reinvent! Projects will not only center on using both found objects and recycled materials, but also on utilizing natural materials. These might include a paper-making unit, recycled textile bags, and/or woven crafts. We will also experiment with plant-based inks and twig bookbinding.

Grades 2-3 – Actor's Workshop

Calling all actors! In Actor's Workshop, we will learn key elements of theatre performance and rehearse speaking in front of an audience. We will hone individual skills and collaborate in ensemble work such as play building and scene study.

FRIDAY

Grade Pre-K – Actor's Playground

Have you ever wondered why they call it a play? BECAUSE ACTING IS FUN! In this play-based drama class, students will experiment with improvisation, ensemble-building, and acting exercises to discover the joy of theatre. All the world's a stage (or a playground) in this energetic and active class.

Grades K-1 – Dance Studio

The essence of this class is the joy of expression through different forms of dance. The young dancer will experience such dance styles as tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, just to name a few. So, sway on over to this class if you're interested in learning a variety of dance and creative movement styles!

Grades K-1 – Global Art

Let's see the world through the eyes of artists! We are going to paint, draw and create our way around the world, visiting countries and cultures. Through different stories, celebrations, and traditions we are going to bring the world to our classroom.

Grades 2-3 – Pop Choir

Is music in your soul? Then sing it! Work those vocal chords and see what it takes to be part of a chorus through learning and performing contemporary pop songs! Singers will explore harmonies, melodies, and the vocal techniques to sing songs in a whole new way.

Grades 2-3 – Yoga

Yoga is a great way to maintain fitness and health. It is a form of exercise connecting the body and mind through poses, breathing control, and meditation. These yoga sessions will combine emotional reflection, light stretching, breathing, various yoga poses, and meditation. Students will learn downward facing dog, upward facing dog, child's pose, windmill pose, frog pose, tortoise pose, and more.
