

### About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 40, and work in partnership with PS 40 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

### A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan's central meeting area at PS 40.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM.
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00PM.
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00PM. A fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6:00PM; fee increases after third late pick-up. *\*Consistent early pick-ups (before 5:00PM) will not be accommodated.*

### Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

### Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. ### Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

# Class Descriptions

## Fall 2018

### **MONDAY**

#### **Grade K – Play Makers**

Students will create their own plays using techniques that explore movement, character, conflict, and storytelling. Improvisational games lead to written scenes that express each student's imagination and address their unique worldview. The class culminates in a student-produced play.

#### **Grades K-1 – Super Soccer Stars** \*\$40 Insurance Fee

Come and learn about the world's most popular sport in this fun and active class. Super Soccer Stars will teach all students basic skills, warm-ups, and tips on how to keep fit. In addition to the physical benefits, this class teaches teamwork and fosters self-confidence in every athlete!

#### **Grades 1-3 – Mini-Musical**

Shine bright and become a star! Through acting, singing, and dancing activities we will work together to create our own Mini-Musical. Not only will you get to work on your turns and time-steps, but you will also learn what it takes to create your own original musical!

#### **Grades 1-3 – Mad Science** \*\$60 Materials Fee

Calling all mad scientists! This class is full of bizarre experiments guaranteed to amaze every participant! Every class involves gooey, slimy, scientific fun, most of which can be taken home from class. Discover how cool science can be in our MAD SCIENTIST LAB!

#### **Grades 2-4 – Jewelry & Fashion Design** \*\$15 Materials Fee

In this class, students will make fashionable jewelry and clothing to wear! Some projects may include coiled wire rings, beading, clay bead making, stone wrapping, and brass hammering. Students will also learn basic sewing and do-it-yourself fashion, starting with drawing their own designs. Students will learn basic stitches, ways to sew without using a machine, and how to cut a basic pattern. Culminating projects will include revamping old t-shirts and jazzing up accessories such as belts, shoelaces, and headbands. Whatever you make, you wear!

#### **Grades 3-5 – Songwriter's Studio**

Students will examine the craft of songwriting through the use of poetry, percussion, and singing. We will write songs as a group and individually, and each student will develop proper singing techniques and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary. Discover your creative genius and become a songwriting superstar!

#### **Grades 4-5 – Masters of Media**

Empowering young people to activate their voices, minds, and bodies through creation and research. This class utilizes the students' critical thinking skills as they examine their personal and societal experience of being a young artist. The class will use age-appropriate entertainment - tv shows, movies, music, magazines - to see both good and lacking examples of master artists in media. The students in turn will create the magazine / tv show / movie they'd like to see. We will also explore master artists throughout history, both by learning through media and creating sketches based on their stories. Once a month we will also have a physical fitness class that will be processed-based, helping the students feel more confident and capable in their bodies.



# Class Descriptions

## Fall 2018

### **TUESDAY**

#### **Grade K – Art Safari**

Discover the world of art with a Wingspan Arts Teaching Artist as your guide! We will explore art from across the globe. Through different folktales, celebrations, and traditions, we are going to bring the world to our classroom. Students will gain experience in drawing and painting as well as mixed media and sculpture. This is a great class in which to explore a variety of artistic mediums and art styles from around the world!

#### **Grades K-1 – Sing Me A Story**

In this creative music class, young musicians express themselves by acting out stories and writing original songs. Through theatre games and improvisation, they'll learn some basic tools of scene writing and songwriting. After playing out a few well-known stories, they'll work together to create their own original story – and write their own all-original musical play! The young musicians will then rehearse the piece they have written and perform it in the Wingspan Arts showcase.

#### **Grades 1-3 – Actor's Toolkit**

In Actor's Toolkit, students will build their skills in imaginative storytelling and improvisation. Through theatre games and ensemble-building activities, the actors in this class will learn about character development, plot structure, and scene study. Students will develop their emotional awareness and social skills, while also building their toolkit to become great actors!

#### **Grades 1-3 – Super Soccer Stars \*\$40 Insurance Fee**

Come and learn about the world's most popular sport in this fun and active class. Super Soccer Stars will teach all students basic skills, warm-ups, and tips on how to keep fit. In addition to the physical benefits, this class teaches teamwork and fosters self-confidence in every athlete!

#### **Grades 2-4 – Creative Kitchen \*\$25 Materials Fee**

In this class, students will explore the culinary arts! Using lots of different ingredients, techniques, and recipes, our budding chefs will incorporate literacy and math to figure out what really goes into the delicious goodies they make. Cookies, breads, salads, and other exciting treats will be the focus of this semester. There will also be chances to be kitchen scientists and make up your own recipes!

#### **Grades 3-5 – Hip Hop**

With a combination of old school and new school hip hop, you'll learn cutting edge street dance movements like popping, locking, hitting, jamming, the nay nay, break, and other urban dance moves. This class gives you a hip-hop dance experience unlike any other.

#### **Grades 4-5 – Game Design \*\$15 Materials Fee**

Grab your dice, create a character, and go where your imagination takes you! In Game Design students will learn how to design their own role-playing games through a variety of thinking strategies and hands-on exercises. Dynamic character drawings, imaginative storytelling, and action-based rule-making are concepts students will explore as they learn the mechanics of choices and outcomes, order of operations, and collaborative play. This class will combine visual arts and creative play to build the ultimate gaming zone.

### WEDNESDAY

#### **Grades K-1 – Spanish Adventures with Lango** \*\$15 Additional Fee

This class combines songs, movement, art and crafts, and language activities to create a Spanish-learning experience unlike any other. This class is designed to foster an interest in foreign languages and cultures, as well as promote the development of a child's linguistic abilities. In addition to learning basic vocabulary words and phrases (e.g. colors, numbers, animals, etc.), all afterschool students will read a book from our signature Lango Kids series. These books follow the Lango Kids--Wen, Luc, and Lucia,--their teacher, and Cosmo the dog on their various adventures throughout the Spanish-speaking world. Each story focuses on a specific set of specialized vocabulary and usually contains a sweet and simple moral. This semester Spanish students are headed to a city, reading "An Adventure in the City."

#### **Grades K-1 – Beginning Karate with KP for Kids** (New Students) \*\$40 Insurance Fee, \$30 Uniform Fee

KP for Kids is a professional karate afterschool program staffed with well-trained instructors that demonstrate respectful behavior in an active, physical, fun-loving environment. It is our philosophy that all children must be treated respectfully in order to emulate that behavior towards others. Additionally, children should have access to a safe, healthy, encouraging afterschool activity that will help develop not only their physical abilities, but also their mental focus and concentration. KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities.

#### **Grades 1-3 – Weird Crazy Science** \*\$25 Materials Fee

Do you love doing homemade science experiments? Do you hope that some day you'll grow up to be a mad scientist? If you screamed "yes!," then Weird Crazy Science is the Wingspan Arts class for you! We will be exploring the world of exciting, hands-on, and homemade science experiments. Think explosions, electricity, chemical reactions, and all sorts of scientific investigations. Join us and make your mad scientist dreams come true!

#### **Grades 1-3 – Pop Choir**

Is music in your soul? Then sing it! Work those vocal chords and see what it takes to be part of a chorus through learning and performing contemporary pop songs! Singers will explore harmonies, melodies, and the vocal techniques to sing songs in a whole new way.

#### **Grades 2-4 – Acting & Improv**

Have you ever wanted to try acting? Or create characters and tell stories with in-the-moment inspiration? Then Acting & Improv is for you! This class will include readings of well-known stories and students will use humor and theatre games on this improvisational journey.

#### **Grades 3-5 – Mixed Media Art**

Mixed Media Arts uses an array of materials to emphasize creativity, invention, and fun! Projects include sculpture (clay, foam, paper, wire); carving (linoleum, potatoes, soap); mobile and collage work. Each week, students will learn about a famous artist while studying technique, craft, media, and art history. Using this knowledge, students will then create projects inspired by these artists.



# Class Descriptions

## Fall 2018

### **Grades 4-5 – Film & Television with Showrunner Productions** \*\$40 Materials Fee

Filmmaking is not just for movie theatres anymore! Students will learn to produce content for film, video, and the web using professional video, lighting and sound equipment. Using video clips, the class begins with an overview of the history of of filmmaking from silent movies to YouTube. They will write, storyboard, produce, and star in their choice of short films, commercials or sitcoms. A link to the final projects will be provided for download.

## **THURSDAY**

### **Grade K-1 – Movin' & Groovin'**

This high-energy class combines rhythm and dance to get everyone movin' to the beat! Explore different beats and rhythms, and find new ways to move to the groove.

### **Grades K-1 – Lego Engineers** \*\$15 Materials Fee

In this class, students experience the excitement of Lego and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all while students use their imaginations to build the most amazing creations! We will learn about famous pieces of art and architecture, explore 2D mosaics, and build upwards in 3D. Students will be able to build individually and in groups, giving them a sense of ensemble and how their pieces and fun ideas fit into the whole.

**Grades 1-6 – Karate with KP for Kids** (New & Returning Students) \*\$40 Insurance Fee, \$30 Uniform Fee will also apply for new students or for replacement uniforms

Students will spend an extra half hour each week perfecting the art of karate. Dedicated students train in kumite, advanced kata, meditation, and choreographed fight combinations.

This class is designed for students who want to develop and hone their artistic vision. Surrounded by other young sculptors, painters, or illustrators, we will work toward an understanding of each artist's voice. This class is for young artists who want to experiment and develop skills with new and familiar mediums!



# Class Descriptions

## Fall 2018

### **Grades 3-5 – Creative Writing**

In this class, we will explore the creative extremes of our imagination! Students will learn about story structure, exposition, plot, and conflict, while also exploring the creative writing process by writing their own short stories.

### **Grades 4-5 – Kodo Plus Game Design with CodeAdvantage \*\$60 Materials Fee**

Get the advantage! The objective in our coding, robotics, and engineering classes is to introduce fundamental coding concepts to young students using a fun and engaging approach. We accomplish this with a mix of programming activities, unplugged activities, and class coding projects. Kids have a blast creating their own 3D video games and adventures such as Bumper Balloons and Super-Kodu while learning fundamental coding concepts such as loops, variables, and constructors.

## **FRIDAY**

### **Grade K – Music Factory**

Through songs, games, and exercises, students will explore the fundamentals of music and composition. Dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat and rhythm will be the focus of this exciting music composition class. The musicians in this class will learn about different instruments and develop skills in songwriting. Students will learn singing techniques, build their knowledge of music theory and terminology, and create their own sounds in the Music Factory!

### **Grades K-1 – Painter's Palette**

Create sketch drawings and turn them into beautiful paintings using a variety of paints and canvases! Learn how to use color and value to create light, shadows, and form. Explore composition, color mixing, painting techniques, and self-expression in this fun class!

### **Grades 1-3 – Dance Studio**

The essence of this class is the joy of expression through different forms of dance. The young dancer will experience dance styles such as jazz, ballet, hip hop, funk, and swing, to name a few. Students will use this knowledge of dance to generate their own choreography and explore new movement styles. This class is geared towards students who love dance and have experience taking dance classes through Wingspan Arts and beyond.

### **Grades 1-3 – Eco Art**

In this class we will learn how to reduce, reuse, and reinvent! Projects will not only center on using both found objects and recycled materials, but also on utilizing natural materials. These might include a paper-making unit, recycled textile bags, and/or woven crafts. We will also experiment with plant-based inks and twig bookbinding.

### **Grades 2-4 – Broadway Bound**

"5, 6, 7, 8!" Get ready for a song and dance experience like never before. This class will explore musical theatre, dance, and music – and give students the chance to do it themselves! Students will master the essentials in acting, and leave the class ready to become a Broadway star!

### **Grades 3-5 – Super Soccer Stars** \*\$40 Insurance Fee

Come and learn about the world's most popular sport in this fun and active class. Super Soccer Stars will teach all students basic skills, warm-ups and tips on how to keep fit. In addition to the physical benefits, this class teaches teamwork and fosters self-confidence in every athlete!

### **Grades 4-5 – Animation with SH!NE** \*\$60 Materials Fee

In Animation, students will have the opportunity to create their own stop motion animation shorts both individually, and as a group. They will learn about storyboards, script writing, and editing in addition to getting the chance to create their own characters, backgrounds, and stories for their films! At the end of the class, students will have practiced all of the jobs required to create a stop motion animation piece and will have created a short film.
