About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at Anderson, and work in partnership with Anderson to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan's central meeting area at Anderson
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00PM
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00PM; a fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6:00PM; Fee increases after third late pick-up.

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

Class Descriptions

Fall 2018

MONDAY

Grades K-1 – Art Explorers

Students will cut, paint, glue, draw, and sculpt! This class will focus on the individuality and creative thinking process of each child as images and three-dimensional forms emerge from stories, poetry, and free association. Concepts will come to life as students develop skills to communicate their ideas in unique ways. This is a great class to explore a variety of artistic mediums.

Grades 1-3 – Actor’s Workshop

Calling all actors! In Actor’s Workshop, we will learn key elements of theatre performance and rehearse speaking in front of an audience. We will hone individual skills and collaborate in ensemble work such as play building and scene study.

Grades 2-4 – STEAM Cooking with *Allergic to Salad* \$25 Materials Fee

We’ve got STEAM heat! This creative culinary class covers components of the scientific method and includes rotating curriculum on kitchen skills and culinary arts, food systems (sustainability, policy, justice, etc.), physical science, and life science. This class delves deeply into full-circle cooking: learning to read a recipe, determining needed ingredient quantities, and making fraction adjustments. Students maintain their own cookbooks for an added literacy component.

Grades 3-5 – Rock Band \$40 Instrument Fee

We will, we will ROCK you! What does it really take to make a rock band? In this class, students will develop a look, style, and sound that’s totally new. They will work with a professional rock musician and put together a set of original music. All students will be rockin’ the house by the end of the semester.

TUESDAY

Grades K-1 – Mandarin Adventure with *Lango* \$15 Materials Fee

This class combines songs, dance, movement, crafts, and language activities to create a Mandarin-learning experience unlike any other. This class is designed to foster an interest in foreign languages and cultures, as well as to promote the development of a child’s linguistic abilities. In addition to learning basic vocabulary words and phrases (e.g. colors, numbers, animals etc.), students will read a book from our signature Lango Kids series. These books follow the Lango Kids--Wen, Luc and Lucia--their teacher and Cosmo the dog on their various adventures throughout the Mandarin-speaking world. Each story focuses on a specific set of specialized vocabulary and usually contains a sweet and simple moral.

Grades 1-3 – Songwriting

Students will examine the craft of songwriting through the use of poetry, percussion, and singing. We will write songs as a group and individually, and each student will develop proper singing techniques and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary. Discover your creative genius and become a songwriting superstar!

Grades 2-4 – Super Soccer Stars *\$40 Insurance Fee*

Come and learn about the world's most popular sport in this fun and active class. Super Soccer Stars will teach you basic skills, warm-ups and tips on how to keep fit. So sign up, build your self-confidence, and become part of the Super Soccer Stars team!

Grades 3-5 – Comedy & Improv

If you like to crack up your friends and family, then this is the class for you. Build up your skills by learning the fundamentals of performing for an audience and making them laugh. This class involves improvisation technique, props, costumes, and character development. Master the art of funny!

WEDNESDAY

Grades K-1 – Mini Musical

"5, 6, 7, 8!" Get ready for a song and dance experience like never before. This class will explore musical theatre, dance, and music – and give students the chance to do it themselves! Students will master the essentials in acting and leave the class ready to become a Broadway star!

Grades 1-3 – Art Studio: Drawing & Painting

Van Gogh, Picasso, and Monet are only some of the names students will learn in this exciting hands-on class. Through the introduction of several painting techniques, students will learn about image composition, drawing, shadows, and light. With a variety of methods, students will learn about art history and also create their own pieces. Students will hone their fine motor skills and enjoy working with watercolor, acrylic, and pastels in this exciting art studio class.

Grades 2-4 – Dance Studio

The essence of this class is the joy of expression through different forms of dance. The young dancer will experience such dance styles as tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, just to name a few. So, sway on over to this class if you're interested in learning a variety of dance and creative movement styles!

Grades 3-5 Lego Robotics with CodingKIDZ \$40 Insurance Fee

Using the LEGO Mindstorms EV3 platform, students build and program walking, talking and thinking robots. Starting with separate LEGO pieces, motors, sensors and a mini-computer, students team up to build robotic creations raging from scorpions to humanoids. They then program their robots to complete missions and participate in hilarious races against other teams in the class.

THURSDAY

Grades K-1 – Jr. Asphalt Jungle with KP All Sports

This energetic class will be having tons of fun in the schoolyard. Get ready for four square, stickball, chalk games, and many more as we explore the most popular games on the playground! And not just recent games – we'll explore games from days past, and have a "ball" on the playground!

Grades 1-3 – Hip Hop

With a combination of old school and new school hip hop, students will learn cutting edge street dance movements like popping, locking, hitting, jamming, electric boogaloo, break, and other urban dance moves. This class gives every student a hip hop dance experience unlike any other.

Grades 2-4 – Modern Masters

This class is for the artist and the art historian alike! In this class, students will learn about and discuss different art genres and periods, such as Impressionism, Fauvism, Pointillism, Art Nouveau, Art Deco, Pop Art, and abstract art. They will then create their own 2D and 3D artworks inspired by these ideas.

Grades 3-5 – Animation with Sh!ne \$60 Materials Fee

In Animation, students will have the opportunity to create their own stop motion animation shorts both individually and as a group. They will learn about storyboards, script writing and editing in addition to getting the chance to create their own characters, backgrounds and stories for their films! At the end of the class, students will have practiced all of the jobs required to create a stop motion animation piece and will have created a short film.

FRIDAY

Grades K-1 – Dance Me a Story

Anyone can tell a story, but can you dance it? As the students learn fun dance steps, they will integrate their new moves into an exciting story...without words! Watch them skip, bop, and shimmy their way from "Once Upon a Time" to "Happily Ever After"!

Grades 1-3 – Lego Architects *\$15 Materials Fee*

In this class, students experience the excitement of Legos and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all while students use their imaginations to build the most amazing creations! We will learn about famous pieces of art and architecture, explore 2D mosaics, and build upwards in 3D. Students will be able to build individually and in groups, giving them a sense of ensemble and how their pieces and fun ideas fit into the whole.

Grades 2-4 – Myths & Legends

What do the Loch Ness Monster, Big Foot, and Paul Bunyan have in common? Well, in Myths & Legends, all their stories will come alive! In this creative class, students will be introduced to drama and theatre through the use of timeless myths and legends. As a final presentation they will stage their very own adaptation or perhaps even create their own story!

Grades 3-5 – Game Design *\$15 Materials Fee*

Grab your dice, create a character, and go where your imagination takes you! In Game Design, students will learn how to design their own role-playing games through a variety of thinking strategies and hands-on exercises. Dynamic character drawings, imaginative storytelling, and action-based rule-making are concepts students will explore as they learn the mechanics of choices and outcomes, order of operations, and collaborative play. This class will combine visual arts and creative play to build the ultimate gaming zone!
