About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at Exceed, and work in partnership with Exceed to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to a central meeting area designated for Wingspan.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 4:40 PM Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays; and until 4:00 PM on Wednesdays.
- Arts Enrichment classes run for 60 minutes from 4:40 - 5:40 PM Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays; and 90 minutes 4:00 - 5:30 PM on Wednesdays.
- Students must participate in their *full class*. Early pick-ups, before the end of class, cannot be accommodated.
- Pick-up is at 5:45 PM Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays; and 5:30 - 5:45 PM on Wednesdays. After 5:45 PM we will be waiting outside. Pick ups starting at 5:30 PM on Wednesdays, are strongly encouraged.
- After classes students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Latest pick-up is at 6:00 PM. A fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6 PM; fee increases after third late pick-up.

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the Arts, regardless of their inability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

Class Descriptions

Fall 2017

MONDAY

Grades K-1 – Storytime Theatre

Let your imagination soar by combining storytelling with theatre! Students will hear classic and contemporary children's stories, and then they'll get a chance to create a menagerie of their own unique characters and plots!

Grades 2-5 – Cartooning & Illustration

Ever wanted your favorite Shopkins character to battle your favorite Pokemon? Ever thought of a new cartoon character? Anything is possible in this class as students master skills in illustration and creating cartoons. All artists will have the opportunity to turn their preliminary sketches into colorful characters as they create their own original illustrated stories!

TUESDAY

Grade K-2 – Legomania *\$15 Materials Fee*

Legos just got even more fun! In this class, students experience the excitement of Legos and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking and problem-solving skills all while using creativity and imagination to build the most amazing creations!

Grades 2-5 – Pop Stars

Become your favorite pop star! From Taylor Swift to Bruno Mars, we will learn to sing and dance like these amazing pop stars - and even create our own performing personalities. Each week we will work on the vocal skills, dance moves, and personal style it takes to become a super star!

WEDNESDAY

Grade PreK & K – Creature Creations

In this hands-on class, students will design their own creatures and then learn the basics of puppet making to make them come to life! There will be lots of brainstorming and building puppets from foam, cardboard, lollipops, Styrofoam balls – even fruits and vegetables! Best of all, every student will get to take their creatures home.

Grades 1-2 – Superhero Theatre

Get your capes ready and imaginations in gear – no phone booth required! This class focuses on finding your inner superhero. Using imagination and creative play, students will develop characters that do great things and help people! At the end of the semester, students will share their superhero stories in an original performance.

Grades 1-3 – Lego Masters \$15 Materials Fee

Learn how to become Lego-smart! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all through the fun of Legos. Build towns, spaceships, bridges, railroads, artwork, and a whole lot more in this exciting class!

Grades 1-5 – Karate with KP for Kids \$40 Insurance Fee

KP for Kids is a professional karate afterschool program staffed with well-trained instructors that demonstrate respectful behavior in an active, physical, fun-loving environment. It is our philosophy that all children must be treated respectfully in order to emulate that behavior towards others. Additionally, children should have access to a safe, healthy, encouraging afterschool activity that will help develop not only their physical abilities, but also their mental focus and concentration. KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities. **If you are a new student, a \$30 uniform fee will also apply.*

THURSDAY

Grades K-1 – Yogamotion

Breathe deeply. Meditate. Stretch. Move! Through the ancient art of yoga, students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. They will have the ability to find balance and focus that will help them throughout the school year.

Grades 2-5 – Actor's Toolkit

In Actor's Toolkit, students will build their skills in imaginative storytelling and improvisation. Through theatre games and ensemble-building activities, the actors in this class will learn about character development, plot structure, and scene study. Students will develop their emotional awareness and social skills, while also building their toolkit to become great actors!

FRIDAY

Grades K-1 – Movin' & Groovin'

This high-energy class combines rhythm and dance to get everyone movin' to the beat! We will explore different dance and movement styles through a wide-range of fun music, imaginative games, and exercises. In this class you will certainly have fun finding new ways to move to the groove!]

Grades 2-5 – Spoken Word & Poetry

In this class, students will delve deep into the techniques of spoken word poetry and rap, learning about metaphors, rhythm, rhyme, poetic structure, and more! We'll mix literacy, music, and performance for a high-energy, multifaceted artistic experience, so get ready to bring the beat!
