### About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at TNS, and work in partnership with TNS to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

### A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan's central meeting area at TNS.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM.
- Arts Enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00PM.
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00 PM. A fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6:00PM; fee increases after third late pick-up.

### Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

### Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. ### Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

# Class Descriptions

## Fall 2018

### Monday

#### **Grades Pre-K & K - Puzzles & Games** *\$15 Materials Fee*

This class will “Boggle” your mind! Learn from the classics, by playing games like Monopoly and chess. Then create your own board games, treasure maps, puzzles, and mazes. You won't be “Sorry” you signed up for this class.

#### **Grades K-1 - Yogamotion**

Breathe deeply. Meditate. Stretch. Move! Through the ancient art of yoga, students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. They will have the ability to find balance and focus that will help them throughout the school year.

#### **Grades 1-3 - Street Art**

Are you inspired by the art you pass on the street? In this class, students will learn the same techniques that street artists, graffiti artists, and guerrilla artists use in the artwork you see everyday. Stenciling, printing, murals, decals, typography, and more will be utilized to bring each student's inspiration to light.

#### **Grades 2-4 - Songwriter's Studio**

Students will examine the craft of songwriting through the use of poetry, percussion, and singing. We will write songs as a group and individually, and each student will develop proper singing techniques and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary. Discover your creative genius and become a songwriting superstar.

#### **Grades 3-5 - Introduction to Robotics (Dash)** *\$40 Materials Fee*

No prior experience required

This beginner's class allows students to program and operate robots that are very responsive to their environment. Students learn to program them to move, dance, light up, make sounds, avoid obstacles, and even react to voice commands. The robots are loaded with sensors that let them know when there is something in front or behind them. They are also equipped with microphones that can hear sound (and even detect where that sound is coming from) and infrared sensors that let them see and communicate with other robots. Students work in teams to complete fun missions and master the robots' capabilities.



# Class Descriptions

## Fall 2018

### Tuesday

#### **Grades Pre-K & K - Jr. Asphalt Jungle**

This energetic class will be having tons of fun in the schoolyard. Get ready for four square, stickball, chalk games, and many more as we explore the most popular games on the playground! And not just recent games - we'll explore games from days past, and have a "ball" on the playground!

#### **Grades K-1 - Lego Artists** *\$15 Materials Fee*

In this class, students experience the excitement of Lego and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all while students use their imaginations to build the most amazing creations! We will learn about famous pieces of art and architecture, explore 2D mosaics, and build upwards in 3D. Students will be able to build individually and in groups, giving them a sense of ensemble and how their pieces and fun ideas fit into the whole.

#### **Grades 1-3 - Mini Musical**

"5, 6, 7, 8!" Get ready for a song and dance experience like you have never had before. This class will explore musical theatre, dance, and music - and give you the chance to do it yourself! Not only will you get to work on your turns and time-steps, but you will also work on creating your own original show!

#### **Grades 2-4 - Costume Design** *\$15 Materials Fee*

This class is a basic sewing and Do-It-Yourself costume design class. We will start with drawing designs creatively and specifically. We will then learn basic stitches and ways to sew without using a machine and how to cut a basic pattern. Culminating projects will include designing and creating simple costumes for our performance classes.

#### **Grades 3-5 - Playwriting & Performance**

Join playwriting and bring your stories to the stage! In this class, students will discover the excitement of playwriting as they bring plot, character, theme, and more to life in the limelight. After an introduction to the basics of dramatic theory and the playwriting process, students will have the opportunity to write and perform their own theatrical masterpiece!

### Wednesday

#### **Grades Pre-K & K - Storytime Theatre**

Let your imagination soar by combining storytelling with theatre! Students will hear classic and contemporary children's stories, and then they'll get a chance to create a menagerie of their own unique characters and plots!

### **Grades K-1 - Painter's Palette**

Create sketch drawings and turn them into beautiful paintings using a variety of paints and canvases! Learn how to use color and value to create light, shadows, and form. Explore composition, color mixing, painting techniques, and self-expression in this fun class!

### **Grades 1-5 - Tae Kwon Do with Olivia** *\$25 Insurance Fee*

Hiyah! In Tae Kwon Do, kids will learn self-defense, get exercise, and have a ton of fun- all while developing self-control, respect, integrity, and perseverance. Every class we will talk about the characteristics of a martial artist and demonstrate them through physical activities such as agility drills, kicking, and basic self-defense techniques. Students will gain confidence and focus, as well as a strong camaraderie with their classmates.

### **Grades 2-4 - Chess**

This class is an introduction to the exciting world of chess. Students will learn basic opening, middle game, and end game strategies and how to achieve a proper coordination of pieces. Instruction will establish an appropriate balance between lecture, discussion, and structured play. Chess puzzles, planning, and guided games will be the highlight of this class!

### **Grades 3-5 - Step & Hip Hop**

Step, stomp, and shake in this advanced Step & Hip Hop class. Students will learn about the cultural evolution of modern Hip Hop and Step by activating their bodies, voices, and minds to create intricate dance pieces. Students will learn introductory steps, basic breakdancing, body rhythms, and the art of street dance in this active and energetic class. Students will also advance to create their own choreography and perform their original pieces.

## **Thursday**

### **Grades Pre-K & K - Music to My Ears**

Through songs, games, and exercises, we'll explore the fundamentals of music. We'll learn about dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm. In the course of our time together we will write our own songs and sing some of our old favorites!



# Class Descriptions

## Fall 2018

### **Grades K-1 - Spanish Adventure with Lango** *\$15 Materials Fee*

This class combines songs, movement, arts and crafts, and language activities to create a Spanish-learning experience unlike any other. This class is designed to foster an interest in foreign languages and cultures, as well as to promote the development of a child's linguistic abilities. In addition to learning basic vocabulary words and phrases (e.g. colors, numbers, animals, etc.), all afterschool students will read a book from our signature Lango Kids series. These books follow the Lango Kids--Wen, Luc, and Lucia--their teacher, and Cosmo the dog on their various adventures throughout the Spanish-speaking worlds. Each story focuses on a specific set of specialized vocabulary and usually contains a sweet and simple moral. This semester, Spanish students are headed to a city, reading "An Adventure in the City."

### **Grades 1-3 - Global Dance**

In this class, dancers will learn styles such as African, jazz, ballet, salsa, Afro-Caribbean, Indian, hip hop, funk and swing. They will dance to music from all over the world and play games that will help them listen to the sounds that make each style and culture unique. This class encourages an awareness and appreciation of other countries' historical dance styles and inspires students to find a common colorful thread that runs through ALL movement.

### **Grades 2-4 - Actor's Workshop**

Calling all actors! In Actor's Workshop, we will learn key elements of theatre performance and rehearse speaking in front of an audience. We will refine individual skills and collaborate in ensemble work such as play building and scene study.

### **Grades 3-5 - Studio Art**

This class is designed for students who want to develop and refine their artistic vision. Surrounded by other young sculptors, painters, and illustrators - we will work toward an understanding of each artist's voice. This class is for young artists who want to experiment and develop skills with new and familiar mediums!

## **Friday**

### **Grades Pre-K & K - Movin' & Groovin'**

This high-energy class combines rhythm and dance to get everyone movin' to the beat! We will explore different dance and movement styles through a wide-range of fun music, imaginative games, and exercises. In this class you will certainly have fun finding new ways to move to the groove!

### **Grades K-2 - Actor's Playground**

Have you ever wondered why they call it a play? Because acting is fun! In this play-based drama class, students will experiment with improvisation, ensemble-building, and acting exercises to discover the joy of theatre. All the world's a stage (or a playground) in this energetic and active thespian experience.

### **Grades 1-5 - Karate with KP for Kids** *\$40 Insurance Fee*

KP for Kids is a professional karate afterschool program staffed with well-trained instructors who demonstrate respectful behavior in an active, physical, fun-loving environment. It is our philosophy that all children must be treated respectfully in order to emulate that behavior towards others. Additionally, children should have access to a safe, healthy, encouraging afterschool activity that will help develop not only their physical abilities but their mental focus and concentration. KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities. *\*If you are a new student, a \$30 uniform fee will also apply.\**

### **Grades 3-5 - Rock Band** *\$40 Materials Fee*

We will, we will ROCK you! What does it really take to make a rock band? In this class, students will develop a look, a style, and a sound that's totally new. They will work with a professional rock musician and put together a set of totally original music. All students will be rockin' the house by the end of the semester.
