About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at YCS, and work in partnership with YCS to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan’s central meeting area at YCS.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM.
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00 PM
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00 PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00 PM. A fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6:00 PM; fee increases after third late pick-up.

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

Class Descriptions

Spring 2018

Monday

Grade Pre-K – Dance Around the World

In this class, dancers will learn styles such as African, jazz, ballet, salsa, Afro-Caribbean, Indian, hip hop, funk, and swing. They will dance to music from all over the world and play games that help them listen to the sounds that make each style and culture unique. This class encourages an awareness and appreciation of other countries' historical dance styles and inspires them to find a common colorful thread that runs through ALL movement.

Grades K-1 – Lego Creations *\$15 Materials Fee*

Legos just got even *more* fun! In this class, students experience the excitement of Legos and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all while encouraging the use of creativity and imagination to build the most amazing creations!

Grades 1-3 – Star Performers

Become your favorite pop star! From Taylor Swift to Bruno Mars, we will learn to sing and dance like these amazing pop stars - and even create our own performing personalities. Each week we will work on the vocal skills, dance moves, and personal style it takes to become a superstar!

Grades 3-5 – Graphic Novels

Ever wanted to star in a graphic novel? Or be the next big cartoonist? Then this is the art class for you! Develop characters and learn to draw their poses and facial expressions in a world you create. By the end of this class, you will have created your very own comic book.

Tuesday

Grade Pre-K – Jr. Asphalt Jungle

This energetic class will be having tons of fun in the schoolyard. Get ready for four square, stickball, chalk games, and many more as we explore the most popular games on the playground! And not just recent games – we'll explore games from days past, and have a "ball" on the playground!

Grades K-1 – Playmakers

Join playmakers and bring your stories to the stage! In this class, students will discover the excitement of playwriting as they bring plot, character, theme, and more to life in the limelight. After an introduction to the basics of dramatic theory and the playwriting process, students will have the opportunity to write and perform their own theatrical masterpiece!

Grades 1-3 – 3D Artists

Let's build! This class is a 3D visual arts class with an emphasis on creativity, fun, and invention! Students will learn sculpture - clay, foam, paper, wire; carving - linoleum, potatoes, soap; 3D printing; mobile and collage. Art lessons will be based on technique, craft media, and art history. Whatever the students will make will be a unique expression of their creativity.

Grades 3-5 – Hip Hop

With a combination of old school and new school hip hop, students will learn cutting edge street dance movements like popping, locking, hitting, jamming, electric boogaloo, break, and other urban dance moves. This club gives every student a hip hop dance experience unlike any other.

Wednesday

Grade Pre-K – Fairytale Theatre

Fairies and goblins and elves, oh my! Combining storytelling with theatre, this creative drama class fosters every student's imagination. Students will explore classic fairytales and might even create a few tales of their own, bringing new characters to life on the stage! This is the perfect class for aspiring actors, playwrights or students who just love the magic and mystery of fairytales.

Grades K-1 – Yogamotion

Breathe deeply. Meditate. Stretch. Move! Through the ancient art of yoga, students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. They will have the ability to find balance and focus that will help them throughout the school year.

Grades 1-3 – Game Design \$15 Materials Fee

Grab your dice, create a character, and go where your imagination takes you! In Game Design, students will learn how to design their own role-playing games through a variety of thinking strategies and hands-on exercises. Dynamic character drawings, imaginative story telling, and action-based rule-making are concepts students will explore as they learn the mechanics of choices and outcomes, order of operations, and collaborative play. This class will combine visual arts and creative play to build the ultimate gaming zone!

Grades 3-5 – Pop Choir

Is music in your soul? Then sing it! Work those vocal chords and see what it takes to be part of a chorus through learning and performing contemporary pop songs! Singers will explore harmonies, melodies, and the vocal techniques to sing songs in a whole new way.

Thursday

Grade Pre-K – Painter’s Palette

Create sketch drawings and turn them into beautiful paintings using a variety of paints and canvases! Learn how to use color and value to create light, shadow, and form. Explore composition, color mixing, painting techniques, and self-expression in this fun class!

Grades K-1 – Mini Musical

“5, 6, 7, 8!” Get ready for a song and dance experience like never before. This class will explore musical theatre, dance, and music – and give students the chance to do it themselves! Students will master the essentials in acting and leave the class ready to become a Broadway star!

Grades 1-5 – Karate with KP for Kids \$40 Insurance Fee

KP for Kids is a professional karate afterschool program staffed with well-trained instructors that demonstrate respectful behavior in an active, physical, fun-loving environment. It is our philosophy that all children must be treated respectfully in order to emulate that behavior towards others. Additionally, children should have access to a safe, healthy, encouraging after school activity that will help develop not only their physical abilities but their mental focus and concentration. KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities. **If you are a new student, a \$30 uniform fee will also apply.**

Grades 3-5 – Comedy & Improv

Master the art of funny! If you like to crack up your friends and family, then this is the class for you. Work with a professional comic to come up with your own gags. This class involves mask work, improvisation technique, props, costumes, and character development. So join this class for a yuck-it-up good time.

Friday

Grade Pre-K – Music Makers

Through songs, games, and exercises, we’ll explore the fundamentals of music. We’ll learn about dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm. In the course of our time, together we will write our own songs and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary.

Grades K-1 – Global Art

Let's see the world through the eyes of artists! We are going to paint, draw and create our way around the world, visiting countries and cultures. Through different stories, celebrations, and traditions we are going to bring the world to our classroom.

Grades 1-3 – Dance Studio

The essence of this class is the joy of expression through different forms of dance. The young dancer will experience such dance styles as tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, just to name a few. So, sway on over to this class if you're interested in learning a variety of dance and creative movement styles!

Grades 3-5 – Cooking Creations with Allergic to Salad \$25 Materials Fee

Fun, hands-on, and from-scratch! Our classes create a platform for a lifetime of adventurous eating and purposeful life-skills. Classes focus on kitchen safety, knife skills and vegetable, fruit and equipment identification. All classes include basic STEM concepts within the cooking lessons. Kids will be cooking up-- and eating-- dishes like spanikopita, sushi, paratha, pumpkin ravioli and more!
