The Wingspan Players are a select group of middle school students who are interested in exploring musical theater. We believe that the best way for young artists to learn theatre is by combining class work alongside production experience; mornings of rehearsal are followed by afternoons full of acting, voice, dance and other performing arts classes.

Students will rehearse and perform a full classic musical theatre production, with production support by Off-Broadway's The New Group.

The Wingspan Ensemble is a select group of high school students who love theater and look forward to exploring more challenging work. Ensemble members participate in master classes, including The New Group's **Scene 1** program, where they develop their individual voices as emerging artists through an ensemble-based model.

Each student also participates in a fully-produced musical or play, with production support by Off-Broadway's The New Group. Students are cast by a professional director in the first week. Recent productions have included, the hit musical *Mean Girls*, and the world premiere of *Hello World*, where students worked with a professional playwright.

HOW TO APPLY

All students must fill out the online application, submit a teacher recommendation and a personal statement. Online application and more information available at wingspanarts.org/conservatory

All students must audition to be considered for this program. Students will be asked to perform a piece of a song and a one-minute monologue. Auditions will be a mix of in-person + Zoom meetings, which we will schedule after the application deadline has passed.
