The Wingspan Ensemble is a select group of high school students who love theatre and look forward to exploring more challenging work. Ensemble members participate in master classes, including The New Group's Scene 1 program, where they develop their individual voices as emerging artists through an ensemble-based model. Students also participate in a fully-produced musical or play, with production support by Off-Broadway's The New Group. Casting takes place during the first week.

## APPLICATION + AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

- All students must fill out the online application, submit a teacher recommendation and a personal statement.

- All students must audition to be considered for this program. Students will be asked to perform a piece of a song and a one-minute monologue.
- Auditions will be a mix of in-person + Zoom meetings, which we will schedule after the application deadline has passed.
