Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 340, and work in partnership with PS 340 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan's central meeting area at PS 340.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:15PM.
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:15 4:45PM.
- Pick-up runs from 4:45 6:00PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00PM. A fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6:00PM; fee increases after third late pick-up.

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Refund Policy

Class Descriptions Fall 2018

MONDAY

Grade Pre-K – Lego Creations *\$15 Materials Fee

Legos just got even *more* fun! In this class, students will experience the excitement and creativity of Legos and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all while using creativity and imagination to build the most amazing creations imaginable!

Grades Pre-K & K – Myths & Legends

What do the Loch Ness Monster, Big Foot, and Paul Bunyan have in common? Well, in Myths & Legends, all their stories will come alive! In this creative class, students will be introduced to drama and theatre through the use of timeless myths and legends. As a final presentation they will stage their very own adaptation or perhaps even create their own story!

Grade K - Global Arts

Let's travel the world! From Italy to Japan, Egypt to Australia, we will explore art from across the globe. Students will paint, sculpt, and sketch their way through different folktales, celebrations, and traditions. We are going to bring the world to our classroom!

Grades K-1 – Mini-Musical

"5, 6, 7, 8!" Get ready for a song and dance experience like you have never had before. This class will explore musical theatre, dance, and music – and give you the chance to do it yourself! Not only will you get to work on your turns and time-steps, but you will also work on creating your own original show!

Grades 1-3 - Art Studio

This class is designed for students who want to develop and refine their artistic vision. Surrounded by other young sculptors, painters, and illustrators – we will work toward an understanding of each artist's voice. This class is for young artists who want to experiment and develop skills with new and familiar mediums!

Grades 2-4 – Super Soccer Stars *\$40 Insurance Fee

TUESDAY

Grade Pre-K – Fairytale Theatre

Fairies and goblins and elves, oh my! Combining storytelling with theatre, this creative drama class fosters every student's imagination. Students will explore classic fairytales and might even create a few tales of their own, bringing new characters to life on the stage! This is the perfect class for aspiring actors, playwrights, or students who just love the magic and mystery of fairytales.

Grades Pre-K & K – Sing Me A Story

In this creative music class, young musicians will express themselves by acting out stories and writing original songs. Through theatre games and improvisation, they'll learn some basic tools of scene writing and songwriting. After playing out a few well-known stories, they'll work together to create their own original story – and write their own all-original musical play! The young musicians will then rehearse the piece they have written and perform it in the Wingspan Arts showcase.

Grade K - Yoga & Pilates with KP ALL SPORTS

KP ALL SPORTS introduces a new class to PS 340 – Yoga and Pilates! This class will introduce students to breath work, proper alignment and moving with the breath. This class includes meditation and incorporates the beneficial core movements of yoga and Pilates. Students will experience the benefits of stress relief, body strengthening and increased flexibility.

Grades K-1 – Hip Hop

With a combination of old school and new school hip hop, students will learn cutting edge street dance movements like popping, locking, hitting, jamming, electric boogaloo, break, and other urban dance moves. This class gives every student a hip hop dance experience unlike any other.

Grades 1-3 – Spanish Adventures with Lango *\$15 Additional Fee

This class combines songs, movement, art and crafts, and language activities to create a Spanish-learning experience unlike any other. This class is designed to foster an interest in foreign languages and cultures, as well as to promote the development of a child's linguistic abilities. In addition to learning basic vocabulary words and phrases (e.g. colors, numbers, animals etc.), all afterschool students will read a book from our signature Lango Kids series. These books follow the Lango Kids--Wen, Luc and Lucia,--their teacher, and Cosmo the dog on their various adventures throughout the Spanish-speaking world. Each story focuses on a specific set of specialized vocabulary and usually contains a sweet and simple moral. This semester Spanish students are headed to a city, reading "An Adventure in the City."

Grades 2-4 – Graphic Novels

In this advanced cartooning class, students will learn to create characters, worlds, and stories using the art of illustration. With a balance of literacy, storytelling, and visual art, the Graphic Novelists from this class will jump head first into the world of cartooning. They will have the opportunity to develop new characters, as well as place their favorite comics in new settings. At the end of the class, students will walk away with their own graphic novel!

WEDNESDAY

Grade Pre-K – Art Explorers

Students will cut, paint, glue, draw, and sculpt! This class will focus on the individuality and creative thinking process of each child as images and three-dimensional forms emerge from stories, poetry, and free association. Concepts will come to life as students develop skills to communicate their ideas in unique ways. This is a great class to explore a variety of artistic mediums.

Grades Pre-K & K – Jr. Asphalt Jungle

This energetic class will be having tons of fun in the schoolyard. Get ready for four square, stickball, chalk games, and many more as we explore the most popular games on the playground! And not just recent games – we'll explore games from days past, and have a "ball" on the playground!

Grade K – Music Factory

Through songs, games, and exercises, students will explore the fundamentals of music and composition. Dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm will be the focus of this exciting music composition class. The musicians in this class will learn about different instruments and develop skills in songwriting. Students will learn singing techniques, build their knowledge of music theory and terminology, and create their own sounds in the Music Factory!

Grades K-1 – Canvas Creations

Van Gogh, Picasso, and Monet are only some of the names students will learn in this exciting hands-on class. Through the introduction of several painting techniques, students will learn about image composition, drawing, shadows, and light. With a variety of methods, students will learn about art history and also create their own pieces. Students will refine their fine motor skills and enjoy working with watercolor, acrylic, and pastels in this exciting art studio class.

Grades 1-3 – Actor's Workshop

Calling all actors! In Actor's Workshop, we will learn key elements of theatre performance and rehearse speaking in front of an audience. We will refine individual skills and collaborate in ensemble work such as play building and scene study.

Grades 2-4 – Step & Hip Hop

Step, stomp, and shake in this advanced Step & Hip Hop class. Students will learn about the cultural evolution of modern Hip Hop and Step by activating their bodies, voices, and minds to create intricate dance pieces. Students will learn introductory steps, basic break-dancing, body rhythms, and the art of street dance in this active and energetic class. Students will also advance to create their own choreography and perform their original pieces.

THURSDAY

Grade Pre-K - Movin' & Groovin'

This high-energy class combines rhythm and dance to get everyone movin' to the beat! Explore different beats and rhythms, and find new ways to move to the groove.

Grades Pre-K & K - Puzzles & Games \$15 Materials Fee

This class will "Boggle" your mind! Learn from the classics, and create your own games in this creative play class. Play board and brain games, create new rules, and identify different types of puzzles - and then make your own! Design and build new games, treasure maps, puzzles, and mazes using classic visual arts techniques! You won't be "Sorry" you signed up for this class.

Grade K - Actor's Playground

Have you ever wondered why they call it a play? BECAUSE ACTING IS FUN! In this play-based drama class, students will experiment with improvisation, ensemble-building, and acting exercises to discover the joy of theatre. All the world's a stage (or a playground) in this energetic and active class.

Grades K-1 – Super Soccer Stars \$40 Insurance Fee

Come and learn about the world's most popular sport in this fun and active class. Super Soccer Stars will teach you basic skills, warm-ups, and tips on how to keep fit. So sign up, build your self-confidence, and become part of the Super Soccer Stars team.

Grades 1-3 – Pop Choir

Is music in your soul? Then sing it! Work those vocal chords and see what it takes to be part of a chorus through learning and performing contemporary pop songs! Singers will explore harmonies, melodies, and the vocal techniques to sing songs in a whole new way.

Grades 2-4 – Mixed Media Arts

Mixed Media Arts uses an array of materials to emphasize creativity, invention, and fun! Projects include sculpture (clay, foam, paper, wire); carving (linoleum, potatoes, soap); mobile, and collage work. Each week, students will learn about a famous artist while studying technique, craft, media, and art history. Using this knowledge, students will then create projects inspired by these artists.

FRIDAY

Grades Pre-K & K - Music Makers

Through songs, games, and exercises, we'll explore the fundamentals of music. We'll learn about dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm. In the course of our time together we will write our own songs and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary.

Grades Pre-K & K - Painter's Palette

Create sketch drawings and turn them into beautiful paintings using a variety of paints and canvases! Learn how to use color and value to create light, shadows, and form. Explore composition, color mixing, painting techniques, and self-expression in this fun class!

Grades K-4 – Karate with KP for Kids \$40 Insurance Fee, \$30 Uniform Fee will also apply for new students or for replacement uniforms

KP for Kids is a professional karate afterschool program staffed with well-trained instructors that demonstrate respectful behavior in an active, physical, fun-loving environment. It is our philosophy that all children must be treated respectfully in order to emulate that behavior towards others. Additionally, children should have access to a safe, healthy, encouraging afterschool activity that will help develop not only their physical abilities, but also their mental focus and concentration. KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities.
