### About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 516, and work in partnership with PS 516 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

### A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan's central meeting area at PS 516
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00PM.
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00PM. A fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6:00PM; fee increases after third late pick-up.

### Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

### Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. ### Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

# **Class Descriptions**

## **Fall 2018**

### **MONDAY**

#### **Grades Pre-K & K - Fairytale Theatre**

Fairies and goblins and elves, oh my! Combine storytelling with theatre and let your imagination soar in this creative drama class. Young artists will explore classic fairytales and bring them to the stage each week; they might even create a few of their own and bring new characters to life! This is the perfect class for aspiring actors, playwrights, and everyone who loves the magic and mystery of fairytales.

#### **Grades K-1 - Dance Around the World**

In this class, dancers will learn styles such as African, jazz, ballet, salsa, Afro-Caribbean, Indian, hip hop, funk, and swing. They will dance to music from all over the world and play games that will help them listen to the sounds that make each style and culture unique. This class encourages an awareness and appreciation of other countries' historical dance styles and inspires students to find a common colorful thread that runs through ALL movement.

#### **Grades 1-3 - Jr. Cartooning**

Visualize your name on the cover of a handmade book! In this class, students will use tactile materials and a wide-array of artistic processes to create their own original works. Get ready to draw, paint, and cartoon! Anything is possible in this class as students master skills in drawing and creating cartoons.

#### **Grades 2-5 - Athletic All-Stars**

A high-energy class filled with relays, ball games, and circle activities! We will learn new and exciting games that involve everyone in a full kinetic experience. Students will also have the opportunity to develop their own games as well!

# Class Descriptions

## Fall 2018

### **Grades K-1 - Creature Creations**

In this hands-on class, students will design their own creatures and then learn the basics of puppet making to make them come to life! There will be lots of brainstorming and building puppets from foam, cardboard, lollipops, Styrofoam balls – even fruits and vegetables! Best of all, every student will get to take their creatures home.

### **Grades 1-3 - Broadway Bound**

This class is for our future Broadway stars. Actors will learn what it takes to put together a show from start to finish, complete with acting, singing, and dancing. For those who are interested in learning more about musical theatre, this class will cover everything an actor needs to know to become Broadway bound!

### **Grades 2-5 - Lego Masters** *\$15 Materials Fee*

Learn how to become Lego-smart! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all through the fun of Legos. Build towns, spaceships, bridges, railroads, artwork, and a whole lot more in this exciting class!

## **WEDNESDAY**

### **Grades Pre-K & K - Puzzles & Games** *\$15 Materials Fee*

This class will “Boggle” your mind! Learn from the classics, by playing games like Monopoly and chess. Then create your own board games, treasure maps, puzzles, and mazes. You won't be “Sorry” you signed up for this class.

### **Grades K-1- Mini Musical**

“5, 6, 7, 8!” Get ready for a song and dance experience like you have never had before. This class will explore musical theatre, dance, and music – and give you the chance to do it yourself! Not only will you get to work on your turns and time-steps, but you will also work on creating your own original show!

### **Grades 1-3 - Lego Artists** *\$15 Materials Fee*

In this class, students experience the excitement of Lego and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all while students use their imaginations to build the most amazing creations! We will learn about famous pieces of art and architecture, explore 2D mosaics, and build upwards in 3D. Students will be able to build individually and in groups, giving them a sense of ensemble and how their pieces and fun ideas fit into the whole.



# **Class Descriptions**

## **Fall 2018**

### **Grades 2-5 - Future Choreographers**

The essence of this class is the joy of expression through different forms of dance. The young dancer will experience dance styles such as jazz, ballet, hip hop, funk, and swing, to name a few. Students will use this knowledge of dance to generate their own choreography and explore new movement styles. This class is geared towards students who love dance and have experience taking dance classes through Wingspan Arts and beyond.

## **THURSDAY**

### **Grades Pre-K & K - Sing Me a Story**

In this creative music class, young musicians express themselves by acting out stories and writing original songs. Through theatre games and improvisation, they'll learn some basic tools of scene writing and songwriting. After playing out a few well-known stories, they'll work together to create their own original story - and write their own all-original musical play! The young musicians will then rehearse the piece they have written and perform it in the Wingspan Arts showcase.

### **Grades K-1 - Chess**

Join us for this introduction to the exciting world of chess. Students will learn basic opening, middle game, and end game strategies and how to achieve a proper coordination of pieces. Instruction will establish an appropriate balance between lecture, discussion, and structured play. Chess puzzles, planning, and guided games will also be a fun part of this class!

### **Grades 1-3 - Hip Hop**

With a combination of old school and new school hip hop, dancers will learn cutting edge street dance movements like popping, locking, hitting, jamming, electric boogaloo, break and other urban dance moves. This class gives every dancer a hip hop dance experience unlike any other.

### **Grades 2-5 - Cartooning & Illustration**

Ever wanted your favorite Shopkins character to battle your favorite Pokemon? Ever thought of a new cartoon character? Anything is possible in this class as students master skills in illustration and cartooning. All artists will have the opportunity to turn their preliminary sketches into colorful characters as they create their own original illustrated stories!

### **FRIDAY**

#### **Grades Pre-K & K - Movin' & Groovin'**

This high-energy class combines rhythm and dance to get everyone movin' to the beat! We will explore different dance and movement styles through a wide-range of fun music, imaginative games, and exercises. In this class you will certainly have fun finding new ways to move to the groove!

#### **Grades K-1 - Myths & Legends**

What do the Loch Ness Monster, Big Foot, and Paul Bunyan have in common? Well, in Myths & Legends, all their stories will come alive! In this creative class, students will be introduced to drama and theatre through the use of timeless myths and legends. As a final presentation they will stage their very own adaptation or perhaps even create their own story!

#### **Grades 1-3 - Songwriter's Studio**

Students will examine the craft of songwriting through the use of poetry, percussion, and singing. We will write songs as a group and individually, and each student will develop proper singing techniques and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary. Discover your creative genius and become a songwriting superstar.

#### **Grades 2-5 - Sketch Comedy**

If you like to crack up your friends and family, then this is the class for you. Build up your skills by learning the fundamentals of performing for an audience and making them laugh. This class involves improvisation technique, props, costumes, and character development. Master the art of funny!
