About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at YCS, and work in partnership with YCS to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan’s central meeting area at YCS
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00PM
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00PM; a fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6:00PM; fee increases after third late pick-up.

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

Class Descriptions

Fall 2018

Monday

Grade Pre-K – Music to My Ears

Through songs, games, and exercises, we'll explore the fundamentals of music. We'll learn about dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm. In the course of our time together we will write our own songs and sing some of our old favorites!

Grades K-1 – Yogamotion

Breathe deeply. Meditate. Stretch. Move! Through the ancient art of yoga, students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. They will have the ability to find balance and focus that will help them throughout the school year.

Grades 1-3 – Pop Choir

Is music in your soul? Then sing it! Work those vocal chords and see what it takes to be part of a chorus through learning and performing contemporary pop songs! Singers will explore harmonies, melodies, and the vocal techniques to sing songs in a whole new way.

Grades 2-5 – Global Art

Let's travel the world! From Italy to Japan, Egypt to Australia, we will explore art from across the globe. Students will paint, sculpt, and sketch their way through different folktales, celebrations, and traditions. We are going to bring the world to our classroom!

Tuesday

Grade Pre-K – Jr. Asphalt Jungle

This energetic class will be having tons of fun in the schoolyard. Get ready for four square, stickball, chalk games, and many more as we explore the most popular games on the playground! And not just recent games – we'll explore games from days past, and have a "ball"!

Grades K-1 – Puppets & Performance

Create your own puppets and bring them to life! This class will give students a chance to build puppets from a variety of fun materials. Best of all, every student will get to take their puppets home! The class culminates in a puppet show at the end of the semester.

Grades 1-3 – Dance Studio

The essence of this class is the joy of expression through different forms of dance. The young dancer will experience such dance styles as tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, just to name a few. So, sway on over to this class if you're interested in learning a variety of dance and creative movement styles!

Grades 2-5 – Cooking Creations with Allergic to Salad \$25 Materials Fee

Fun, hands-on, and from-scratch! Our classes create a platform for a lifetime of adventurous eating and purposeful life-skills. Classes focus on kitchen safety, knife skills, and vegetable, fruit, and equipment identification. All classes include basic STEM concepts within the cooking lessons. Kids will be cooking up-- and eating-- dishes like spanikopita, sushi, paratha, pumpkin ravioli, and more!

Wednesday

Grade Pre-K – Dance Around the World

In this class, dancers will learn styles such as African, jazz, ballet, salsa, Afro-Caribbean, Indian, hip hop, funk, and swing. They will dance to music from all over the world and play games that will help them listen to the sounds that make each style and culture unique. This class encourages an awareness and appreciation of other countries' historical dance styles and inspires students to find a common colorful thread that runs through ALL movement.

Grades K-1 – Painter's Palette

Create sketch drawings and turn them into beautiful paintings using a variety of paints and canvases! Learn how to use color and value to create light, shadows and form. Explore composition, color mixing, painting techniques, and self-expression in this fun class!

Grades 1-3 – Actor's Toolkit

In Actor's Toolkit, students will build their skills in imaginative storytelling and improvisation. Through theatre games and ensemble-building activities, the actors in this class will learn about character development, plot structure, and scene study. Students will develop their emotional awareness and social skills, while also building their toolkit to become great actors!

Grades 3-5 – Hip Hop

With a combination of old school and new school hip hop, students will learn cutting edge street dance movements like popping, locking, hitting, jamming, electric boogaloo, break, and other urban dance moves. This club gives every student a hip hop dance experience unlike any other.

Thursday

Grade Pre-K – Art Explorers

Students will cut, paint, glue, draw, and sculpt! This class will focus on the individuality and creative thinking process of each child as images and three-dimensional forms emerge from stories, poetry, and free association. Concepts will come to life as students develop skills to communicate their ideas in unique ways. This is a great class to explore a variety of artistic mediums.

Grades K-2 – Star Performers

Become your favorite pop star! From Taylor Swift to Bruno Mars, we will learn to sing and dance like these amazing pop stars - and even create our own performing personalities. Each week we will work on the vocal skills, dance moves, and personal style it takes to become a super star!

Grades 1-5 – Karate with KP for Kids \$40 Insurance Fee

KP for Kids is a professional karate afterschool program staffed with well-trained instructors that demonstrate respectful behavior in an active, physical, fun-loving environment. It is our philosophy that all children must be treated respectfully in order to emulate that behavior towards others. Additionally, children should have access to a safe, healthy, encouraging after school activity that will help develop not only their physical abilities but also their mental focus and concentration. KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities. **If you are a new student, a \$30 Uniform Fee will also apply.**

Grades 3-5 – Sketch Comedy

If you like to crack up your friends and family, then this is the class for you. Build up your skills by learning the fundamentals of performing for an audience and making them laugh. This class involves improvisation technique, props, costumes, and character development. Master the art of funny!

Friday

Grade Pre-K – Actor’s Playground

Through songs, games, and exercises, we’ll explore the fundamentals of music. We’ll learn about dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm. In the course of our time, together we will write our own songs and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary.

Grades K-1 – Dance Me a Story

Anyone can tell a story, but can you dance it? As the students learn fun dance steps, they will integrate their new moves into an exciting story...without words! Watch them skip, bop, and shimmy their way from “Once Upon a Time” to “Happily Ever After”!

Grades 1-3 – Art of Comics

Ever wanted Wiley Coyote to catch the Road Runner? Ever thought of a new cartoon character? Anything is possible in this class as students develop skills in drawing and creating cartoons. All artists will have the opportunity to turn their preliminary sketches into colorful characters as they create their own original comic strip!

Grades 3-5 – Broadway Bound

This class is for our future Broadway stars. Actors will learn what it takes to put together a show from start to finish, complete with acting, singing and dancing. For those who are interested in learning more about musical theatre, this class will cover everything an actor needs to know to become Broadway bound!
