About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 183, and work in partnership with PS 183 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan’s central meeting area at PS 183.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM.
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00 PM.
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00 PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00 PM; a fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6 PM; fee increases after third late pick-up. **Consistent early pick-ups (before 5:00 PM) will not be accommodated.*

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

Class Descriptions

MONDAY

Grades Pre-K & K – Toymaker’s Workshop *\$15 Materials Fee

Have you ever wondered how they make your favorite toys? Let’s find out! In this hands-on class, students will learn the science and engineering behind how toys work. Students will create and design their own toys and develop new ways to play. This visual arts class combines imagination and curiosity, and the students will take home many handmade toys.

Grades K-1 – Acting & Improv

Students will learn the skills of Acting and Improvisation in this hands-on, spontaneous theatre class. Actors will learn the basic rules of improv to develop and hone their skills as performers. They will learn to SAY YES and “roll with it” through their exploration of acting techniques, games, and exercises. Students will create exciting characters, conflicts, and stories by using their voices, bodies, and imaginations. The class will culminate in an improv performance for all to enjoy!

Grades 1-3 – Dance Studio

Dancers in this class will experience the joy of expression through different forms of dance. Students will be introduced to tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, as well as the historical influence these dance styles have had in the movement world. Dance terminology, core strength, balance, and imagination will drive this class to a creative dance performance at the end of the semester.

Grades 2-4 – Art of Science * \$15 Materials Fee

In Art of Science, students explore science creatively by using their right brain and all of their senses. They'll taste the periodic table and discover the science of music. Students will explore the solar system, space, and even dinosaurs through dance, theatre games, and puppetry. They will paint, color, and craft experiments that help them understand friction, force, chemical reactions, and so much more! This class is perfect for the creative and the curious.

Grades 3-5 – Animation with Sh!ne *\$60 Materials Fee

In Animation, students will have the opportunity to create their own stop motion animation shorts both individually and as a group. They will learn about storyboards, script writing and editing in addition to getting the chance to create their own characters, backgrounds and stories for their films! At the end of the class, students will have practiced all of the jobs required to create a stop motion animation piece and will have created a short film.

TUESDAY

Grades Pre-K & K – Art Explorers

Students will cut, paint, glue, draw, and sculpt! This class will focus on the individuality and creative thinking process of each child as images and three-dimensional forms emerge from stories, poetry, and free association. Concepts will come to life as students develop skills to communicate their ideas in unique ways. This is a great class to explore a variety of artistic mediums.

Grades K-2 – Dance Me A Story

Dance is one of the most graceful and exciting ways to tell a story. The students in this class will use stories to inspire choreography. Blending the exciting elements of plot, music dynamics, and movement, students in this class will integrate their learning into a spectacular visual story. Watch them skip, bop, and shimmy their way from “Once Upon a Time” to “Happily Ever After”!

Grades 1-5 – Karate with KP for Kids \$40 Insurance Fee, *\$30 uniform fee will also apply for new students or for replacement uniforms*

Students will spend an extra half hour each week perfecting the art of karate. Dedicated students train in kumite, advanced kata, meditation, and choreographed fight combinations.

KP for Kids is a professional karate afterschool program staffed with well-trained instructors that demonstrate respectful behavior in an active, physical, fun-loving environment. It is KP’s philosophy that all children must be treated respectfully in order to emulate that behavior towards others. Additionally, children should have access to a safe, healthy, encouraging afterschool activity that will help develop not only their physical abilities but their mental focus and concentration. KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities.

Grades 3-5 – Creative Writing

In this class, students will explore the creative extremes of our imagination! Students will learn about story structure, exposition, plot, and conflict, while also exploring the creative writing process by writing their own short stories.

WEDNESDAY

Grades Pre-K & K – Movin' & Groovin'

This high-energy class combines rhythm and dance to get everyone movin' to the beat! Students will explore different dance and movement styles through a wide-range of fun music, imaginative games, and exercises. Students will focus on balance, rhythm, and technique on their creative search to find new ways to move to the groove!

Grades K-1 – Puppets & Play

Puppeteers will design, build, and activate their puppets in this hands-on and creative class. This class will give students a chance to research the mechanics and engineering of puppet design, while also using their imaginations to create new characters! Students will build puppets from lollipops, styrofoam balls, vegetables and fruit, and pop-up paper, and then bring them to life through acting exercises and techniques. The class culminates in a puppetry performance at the end of the semester!

Grades 1-3 – Lego Masters * \$15 Materials Fee

In this class, students experience the excitement of Lego and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all while students use their imaginations to build the most amazing creations! We will learn about famous pieces of art and architecture, explore 2D mosaics and build upwards in 3D. Students will be able to build individually and in groups, giving them a sense of ensemble and how their pieces and fun ideas fit into the whole.

Grades 2-4 – Broadway Bound

This class is for future Broadway stars. Performers will learn what it takes to put together a show from start to finish, complete with acting, singing and dancing. Students will learn and create choreography, practice monologues and scenes, and develop their own song book! For those who are interested in learning more about musical theatre, this class will cover everything an actor needs to know to become Broadway bound!

Grades 3-5 – Mixed Media Arts

Mixed Media Arts uses an array of materials to emphasize creativity, invention, and fun! Projects include sculpture (clay, foam, paper, wire); carving (linoleum, potatoes, soap), mobile and collage work. Each week, students will learn about a famous artist while studying technique, craft, media, and art history. Using this knowledge, students will then create projects inspired by these artists.

THURSDAY

Grades Pre-K & K – Page to Stage

Students will let their imaginations soar by combining storytelling with theatre! Students will hear classic and contemporary children's stories, and then they'll get a chance to create their own unique characters and plots! Through theatre games, acting exercises, and imaginative play, students will learn to bring the page to the stage in this literary performance class.

Grades K-1 – Canvas Creations

Van Gogh, Picasso, and Monet are only some of the names students will learn in this exciting hands-on class. Through the introduction of several painting techniques, students will learn about image composition, drawing, shadows, and light. With a variety of methods, students will learn about art history and also create their own pieces. Students will refine their fine motor skills and enjoy working with watercolor, acrylic, and pastels in this exciting art studio class.

Grades 1-3 – Pop Choir

Students will become "pitch perfect" by joining the vocal ensemble in Pop Choir. Singers will learn about melodies, harmonies, acapella, and solo performances while singing their favorite pop hits. Ariana Grande, Shawn Mendez, and Bruno Mars are just some of the musical influences inspiring the singers in this class. Students will perform their greatest hits at the end of the semester!

Grades 2-4 – Improv Workshop

Students will learn the skills of Acting and Improvisation in this hands-on, spontaneous theatre class. Actors will learn the basic rules of improv to develop and hone their skills as performers. They will learn to SAY YES and "roll with it" through their exploration of acting techniques, games, and exercises. Students will create exciting characters, conflicts, and stories by using their voices, bodies, and imaginations. The class will culminate in an improv performance for all to enjoy!

Grades 3-5 – Super Scratch with Code Advantage *\$60 Materials Fee

Scratch uses a graphic programming language developed at MIT. This class creates a beginner foundation in programming which can be used in other advanced programming languages. In Super Scratch, young students will learn fundamental programming concepts by creating different adventures using animations and storytelling. Kids will program Scratch to do magic tricks, go on a treasure hunt, and even explore nature!

No previous programming skills are required, but students should be comfortable using a computer and managing files.

Grades Pre-K & K – Music To My Ears

Singers will develop proper vocal technique in this introductory music class. Through songs, games, and exercises, students will explore the fundamentals of vocal performance, and the joy that singing brings! Students will sing, move, and enjoy listening to music that ranges from Tchaikovsky to Frank Sinatra, and even some of Broadway's top hits! By the end of the semester, each student will use their understanding of music composition to sing their hearts out in an original performance.

Grades K-1 – Cooking Creations with Allergic to Salad *\$25 Materials Fee

Fun, hands-on, and from-scratch! Our classes create a platform for a lifetime of adventurous eating and purposeful life-skills. Classes focus on kitchen safety, knife skills and vegetable, fruit and equipment identification. All classes include basic STEM concepts within the cooking lessons. Kids will be cooking up - and eating-- dishes like spanikopita, sushi, paratha, pumpkin ravioli and more!

Grades 1-3 – Backyard Sports

Four square, handball, tag games, stickball... If you can play it in the backyard, students will play it here! This high-energy class brings everyone's favorite games together, from traditional sports like soccer and wiffle ball, to more unique games like ga-ga and obstacle courses. Backyard Sports introduces students to games that will teach both friendly cooperation *and* healthy competition.

Grades 2-4 – Songwriter's Studio

Students will examine the craft of songwriting through the use of poetry, percussion, and singing. Students will write songs both individually and as an ensemble, and each student will develop proper singing techniques and a core understanding of musical vocabulary. By the end of the semester, students will write and perform their own original songs!

Grades 3-5 – Hip Hop

With a combination of old school and new school hip hop, you'll learn cutting edge street dance movements like popping, locking, hitting, jamming, electric boogaloo, break, and other urban dance moves. This class gives you a hip hop dance experience unlike any other.
