We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 267, and work in partnership with PS 267 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan's central meeting area at PS 267
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 5:00 PM
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 5:50 PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 5:50 PM; a fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 5:50 PM; fee increases after third late pick-up. *Consistent early pick-ups (before 5:00 PM) will not be accommodated.

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. MONDAY

Grades K to 1st - Fairytale Theatre

Fairies and goblins and elves, oh my! Students will combine storytelling with theatre and let their imaginations soar in this creative drama class. Young artists will explore classic fairytales and bring them to the stage each week. They will also create a their own and bring new characters to life! This class will culminate in the performance of a fairytale!

Grades K to 1st - Myths & Legends

Storytellers in this class will bring Myths & Legends from around the world to life! In this class, students will use skills in literacy, teamwork, and creative thinking to devise staged versions of familiar stories. The Gods of Mount Olympus, Native American Folktales, and stories pertaining to the origin of Greek, Roman, and Egyptian mythology will serve as the foundation of this class. Students will use acting techniques and their curious imaginations to stage an adaptation of a timeless story!

Grades 2nd to 3rd - Singing Sensations

Become your favorite pop star! From Taylor Swift to Bruno Mars, we will learn to sing and dance like these amazing pop stars - and even create our own performing personalities. Each week we will work on the vocal skills, dance moves, and personal style it takes to become a superstar!

Grades 3rd to 5th - Engineering with Launch

Calling all future engineers! This class will involve weekly challenges where students will have to work in teams to come up with their own designs for different projects: a bridge that can bear the greatest load; a model rocket that flies highest; a spring coil car that travels farthest, and other engineering challenges. **\$60 Materials Fee**

TUESDAY

Grades K to 1st - Art Explorers

Students will cut, paint, glue, draw, and sculpt! This class will focus on the individuality and creative thinking process of each child as images and three-dimensional forms emerge from stories, poetry, and free association. Concepts will come to life as students develop skills to communicate their ideas in unique ways. This is a great class to explore a variety of artistic mediums.

Grades K to 1st - Hip Hop

With a combination of old school and new school hip hop, dancers will learn cutting edge street dance movements. Students will pop, lock, jam, and break while also working together to create dynamic dance pieces. Balancing challenging choreography with the students' own creative influence, this class will result in an exciting dance performance.

Grades 2nd to 3rd - Cartooning & Illustration

Ever wanted your favorite Shopkins character to battle your favorite Pokemon? Ever thought of a new cartoon character? Anything is possible in this class as students master skills in illustration and cartooning. All artists will have the opportunity to turn their preliminary sketches into colorful characters as they create their own original illustrated stories!

Grades 3rd to 5th - Cooking Creations with Allergic to Salad

Fun, hands-on, and from-scratch! Our classes create a platform for a lifetime of adventurous eating and purposeful life-skills. Classes focus on kitchen safety, knife skills, and vegetable, fruit, and equipment identification. All classes include basic STEM concepts within the cooking lessons. WEDNESDAY

Grades K to 1st - Lego Masters

Learn how to become Lego-smart! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all through the fun of Legos. Students will build towns, spaceships, bridges, railroads, artwork, and a whole lot more in this exciting class! **\$15 Materials Fee**

Grades K to 1st - Music Makers

Through songs, games, and exercises, students will learn the fundamentals of music. Students will explore dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm - all while learning to sing and play their favorite songs. Musicians in this class will write and perform songs while gaining a basic knowledge of music theory and vocabulary.

Grades 2nd to 3rd - Actor's Toolkit

In Actor's Toolkit, students will build their skills in imaginative storytelling and improvisation. Through theatre games and ensemble-building exercises, the actors in this class will learn about character development, plot structure, and scene study. Students will use their actor tools of body, voice, and imagination to tell stories in a creative and expressive way. The actors will develop their emotional awareness and social skills, while also building their toolkit to become great performers!

Grades 3rd to 5th - Pop Choir

Students will become "pitch perfect" by joining the vocal ensemble in Pop Choir. Singers will learn about melodies, harmonies, acapella, and solo performances while singing their favorite pop hits. Ariana Grande, Shawn Mendez, and Bruno Mars are just some of the musical influences inspiring the singers in this class. Students will perform their greatest hits at the end of the semester!

THURSDAY

Grades K to 1st - Mini Musical

"5, 6, 7, 8!" Learn a dance, sing a song, and perform a monologue in this introductory musical theatre class. Students will learn what it takes to become a triple threat, while also being introduced to many Broadway musicals. Students will work as an ensemble to create their own original musical focusing on the story structure of major Broadway musicals.

Grades K to 1st - Recycled Art

In this class we will learn how to reduce, reuse, and reinvent! Projects will not only center on using both found objects and recycled materials, but also on utilizing natural materials. Find out not only how to save the earth, but make it beautiful!

Grades K to 5th - Karate with KP for Kids

KP for Kids is a professional karate afterschool program staffed with well-trained instructors that demonstrate respectful behavior in an active, physical, fun-loving environment. It is our philosophy that all children must be treated respectfully in order to emulate that behavior towards others. Additionally, children should have access to a safe, healthy, encouraging afterschool activity that will help develop not only their physical abilities, but also their mental focus and concentration. KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities. *\$40 Insurance Fee, \$30 Uniform Fee*

Grades 3rd to 5th - Mixed Media Arts

Mixed Media Arts uses an array of materials to emphasize creativity, invention, and fun! Projects include sculpture (clay, foam, paper, wire); carving (linoleum, potatoes, soap), mobile and collage work. Each week, students will learn about a famous artist while studying technique, craft, media, and art history. Using this knowledge, students will then create projects inspired by these artists.

FRIDAY

Grades K to 1st - Toymaker's Workshop

Have you ever wondered how they make your favorite toys? Let's find out! In this hands-on class, students will learn the science and engineering behind how toys work. Students will create and design their own toys and develop new ways to play. This visual arts class combines imagination and curiosity, and the students will take home many handmade toys. **\$15 Materials Fee**

Grades K to 1st - Jazz Dance

Students in this class will learn the basic principles of jazz dance. Students will groove to syncopated rhythms by stepping, leaping, kicking, and perfecting body isolations with a creative flair. Along with creative movement, students will learn about the evolution of jazz dance in America at the turn of the 20th century, focusing on choreographers and musicals that brought this dance form to the mainstream. The semester will end with a jazzy performance of an original dance piece.

Grades 2nd to 3rd - Dance Studio

Dancers in this class will experience the joy of expression through different forms of dance. Students will be introduced to tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, as well as the historical influence these dance styles have had in the movement world. Dance terminology, core strength, balance, and imagination will drive this class to a creative dance performance at the end of the semester.

Grades 3rd to 5th - Playwriting

Playwrights in this class will bring their stories to the stage! Students will discover the excitement of playwriting as they bring plot, character, theme, and more to life in the limelight. After an introduction to the basics of dramatic theory and the playwriting process, students will have the opportunity to write and perform their own theatrical masterpiece!
