About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 303, and work in partnership with PS 303 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan’s central meeting area at PS 303.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30 PM Monday-Thursday and 3 PM on Fridays
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5 PM Monday-Thursday and 3 - 4:30 PM on Fridays.
- Pick-up runs from 5 - 6 PM Monday-Thursday and 4:40 - 6 PM on Fridays; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6 PM; a fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6 PM; fee increases after third late pick-up. **Consistent early pick-ups (before 5 PM Monday-Thursday, before 4:40 PM on Fridays) will not be accommodated.*

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

Class Descriptions

MONDAY

Grade Pre-K – Lego Creations *\$15 materials fee

Legos just got even *more* fun! In this class, students will experience the excitement and creativity of Legos and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills while using creativity and imagination to build the most amazing creations!

Grades K-1 – Broadway Bound

This class is for future Broadway stars. Performers will learn what it takes to put together a show from start to finish, complete with acting, singing and dancing. Students will learn and create choreography, practice monologues and scenes, and develop their own song book! For those who are interested in learning more about musical theatre, this class will cover everything an actor needs to know to become Broadway bound!

Grades K-1 – Painter's Palette

Create sketch drawings and turn them into beautiful paintings using a variety of paints and canvases! Learn how to use color and value to create light, shadows, and form. Explore composition, color mixing, painting techniques, and self-expression in this fun class!

Grades 2-3 – Pop Choir

Is music in your soul? Then sing it! Work those vocal chords and see what it takes to be part of a chorus through learning and performing contemporary pop songs! Singers will explore harmonies, melodies, and the vocal techniques to sing songs in a whole new way.

Grades 2-3 – Modern Masters

This class is for the artist and the art historian alike! In this class, students will learn about and discuss different art genres and periods, such as Impressionism, Fauvism, Pointillism, Art Nouveau, Art Deco, Pop Art, and abstract art. They will then create their own 2D and 3D artworks inspired by these ideas. Students will also create relationships with the artists of history and develop their own techniques to find their authentic artist self.

TUESDAY

Grade Pre-K – Music to My Ears

Singers will develop proper vocal technique in this introductory music class. Through songs, games, and exercises, students will explore the fundamentals of vocal performance, and the joy that singing brings! Students will sing, move, and enjoy listening to music that ranges from Tchaikovsky to Frank Sinatra, and even some of Broadway's top hits! By the end of the semester, each student will use their understanding of music composition to sing their hearts out in an original performance.

Grades K-1 – Yogamotion

Breathe deeply. Meditate. Stretch. Move! Through the ancient art of yoga, students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. These yoga sessions will combine emotional reflection, light stretching, breathing, various yoga poses, and meditation. Students will learn downward facing dog, upward facing dog, child's pose, windmill pose, frog pose, tortoise pose and more! By the end of the semester, students will feel peaceful sharing all they've learned in a yoga demonstration. Namaste.

Grades K-1 – Acting & Improv

Students will learn the skills of Acting and Improvisation in this hands-on, spontaneous theatre class. Actors will learn the basic rules of improv to develop and hone their skills as performers. They will learn to SAY YES and "roll with it" through their exploration of acting techniques, games, and exercises. Students will create exciting characters, conflicts, and stories by using their voices, bodies, and imaginations. The class will culminate in an improv performance for all to enjoy!

Grades 2-3 – Eco Art

In this class students will learn how to reduce, reuse, and reinvent! Projects will not only center on using both found objects and recycled materials, but also on utilizing natural materials. Find out not only how to save the earth but make it beautiful!

Grades 2-3 – Mini Musical

"5, 6, 7, 8!" Learn a dance, sing a song, and perform a monologue in this introductory musical theatre class. Students will learn what it takes to become a triple threat, while also being introduced to many Broadway musicals. Students will work as an ensemble to create their own original musical focusing on the story structure of major Broadway musicals.

WEDNESDAY

Grade Pre-K – Dance Me a Story

Dance is one of the most graceful and exciting ways to tell a story. The students in this class will use stories to inspire choreography. Blending the exciting elements of plot, music dynamics, and movement, students in this class will integrate their learning into a spectacular visual story. Watch them skip, bop, and shimmy their way from “Once Upon a Time” to “Happily Ever After”!

Grades K-1 – Circus Arts

This class is going to have you bouncing off the walls...literally! With our clowning and tumbling instructor, students will learn the basics of clowning like you see in circuses! We will also explore the world of tumbling and gymnastics, and team-building activities to culminate in one crazy adventure!

Grades K-1 – Music Makers with Music to Your Home *\$15 Materials Fee

Through songs, games, and exercises, students will explore the fundamentals of music. They will learn about dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm. In this semester students will write their own songs and leave with a core understanding of musical vocabulary.

Grades 2-3 – Actor’s Workshop

Calling all actors! In Actor’s Workshop, students will learn key elements of theatre performance and rehearsal practices. Through monologue and scene study, as well as in-depth character development exercises, the actors in this class will learn the value of objectives, tactics, and stakes in performance. Students will also have the opportunity to develop their own pieces and direct their fellow classmates. At the end of the semester, the actors will show off what they’ve learned in a short play!

Grades 2-3 –World Cooking *\$25 Materials Fee

Take a culinary tour around the world! In this class, students will cook their way around the world and while they are at it, learn about the history and culture of the different places they “visit!”

THURSDAY

Grade Pre-K – Art Safari

Discover the world of art with a Wingspan Arts Teaching Artist as your guide! We will explore art from across the globe. Through different folktales, celebrations, and traditions, we are going to bring the world to our classroom. Students will gain experience in drawing and painting as well as mixed media and sculpture. This is a great class in which to explore a variety of artistic mediums and art styles from around the world!

Grades K-1 – Fairytale Theatre

Fairies and goblins and elves, oh my! Students will combine storytelling with theatre and let their imaginations soar in this creative drama class. Young artists will explore classic fairytales and bring them to the stage each week. They will also create their own and bring new characters to life! This class will culminate in the performance of a fairytale!

Grades K-1 – Backyard Sports

Four square, handball, tag games, stickball... If you can play it in the backyard, students will play it here! Backyard Sports introduces students to games that will teach both friendly cooperation *and* healthy competition.

Grades 2-3 – Dreaming and Devising Theatre

Using the student's imaginations, this class will take the ordinary to the extraordinary as students create their own performance pieces. Students will work together to devise new stories using elements of creative writing, puppetry, and improvisation techniques. As an ensemble, this class will build and perform unique theatre pieces based on their own ideas. If you dream it, you can devise it in this exciting new class.

Grades 2-3 – Dance Studio

Dancers in this class will experience the joy of expression through different forms of dance. Students will be introduced to tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, as well as the historical influence these dance styles have had in the movement world. Dance terminology, core strength, balance, and imagination will drive this class to a creative dance performance at the end of the semester.

FRIDAY

Grade Pre-K – Myths & Legends

Storytellers in this class will bring Myths & Legends from around the world to life! In this class, students will use skills in literacy, teamwork, and creative thinking to devise staged versions of familiar stories. The Gods of Mount Olympus, Native American Folktales, and stories pertaining to the origin of Greek, Roman, and Egyptian mythology will serve as the foundation of this class. Students will use acting techniques and their curious imaginations to stage an adaptation of a timeless story!

Grades K-1 – Dance Around the World

In this class, dancers will learn styles such as African, jazz, ballet, salsa, Afro-Caribbean, Indian, hip hop, funk and swing. They will dance to music from all over the world and participate in games and exercises that will help them listen to the sounds that make each style and culture unique. This class encourages an awareness and appreciation of other countries' historical dance styles and inspires students to find a common, colorful thread that runs through ALL movement.

Grades K-1 – Puppets & Play

Puppeteers will design, build, and activate their puppets in this hands-on and creative class. This class will give students a chance to research the mechanics and engineering of puppet design, while also using their imaginations to create new characters! Students will build puppets from lollipops, Styrofoam balls, vegetables and fruit, and pop-up paper, and then bring them to life through acting exercises and techniques. The class culminates in a puppetry performance at the end of the semester!

Grades 2-3 – Graphic Novels

In this advanced cartooning class, students will learn to create characters, worlds, and stories using the art of illustration. With a balance of literacy, storytelling, and visual art, the Graphic Novelists from this class will jump head first into the world of cartooning. They will have the opportunity to develop new characters, as well as place their favorite comics in new settings. At the end of the class, students will walk away with their own graphic novel!

Grades 2-3 – Songwriter's Studio

Students will examine the craft of songwriting through the use of poetry, percussion, and singing. Students will write songs both individually and as an ensemble, and each student will develop proper singing techniques and a core understanding of musical vocabulary. By the end of the semester, students will write and perform their own original songs!
