## About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at TNS, and work in partnership with TNS to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

## A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan's central meeting area at TNS.
  - Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM.
  - Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00 PM.
  - Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00 PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
  - Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00 PM; a fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6 PM; fee increases after third late pick-up. \**Consistent early pick-ups (before 5:00 PM) will not be accommodated.*

#### **Tax Information**

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

## **Financial Aid**

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. ## Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.

  - If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

# Class Descriptions

## Spring 2019

### Monday

#### Grades Pre-K & K – Art Safari

Discover the world of art with a Wingspan Arts Teaching Artist as your guide! Students will explore art from across the globe. Through different folktales, celebrations, and traditions, students will bring the world to the classroom. Students will gain experience in drawing and painting as well as mixed media and sculpture. This is a great class in which to explore a variety of artistic mediums and art styles from around the world!

#### Grades K-1 – Acting & Improv

Students will learn the skills of Acting and Improvisation in this hands-on, spontaneous theatre class. Actors will learn the basic rules of improv to develop and hone their skills as performers. They will learn to SAY YES and “roll with it” through their exploration of acting techniques, games, and exercises. Students will create exciting characters, conflicts, and stories by using their voices, bodies, and imaginations. The class will culminate in an improv performance for all to enjoy!

#### Grades 1-3 – Art of Comics

Visualize your name on the cover of a handmade book! In this class, students will use tactile materials and a wide-array of artistic processes to create their own original works. Get ready to draw, paint, and cartoon while also creating adventurous and daring new stories! All artists will have the opportunity to turn their preliminary sketches into colorful characters as they create their own original comic strip!

#### Grades 2-4 – Pop Choir

Students will become “pitch perfect” by joining the vocal ensemble in Pop Choir. Singers will learn about melodies, harmonies, acapella, and solo performances while singing their favorite pop hits. Ariana Grande, Shawn Mendez, and Bruno Mars are just some of the musical influences inspiring the singers in this class. Students will perform their greatest hits at the end of the semester!

#### Grades 3-5 – Introduction to Robotics (Dash) \*\$40 Materials Fee

This beginner’s class allows students to program and operate robots that are very responsive to their environment. Students learn to program them to move, dance, light up, make sounds, avoid obstacles, and even react to voice commands. The robots are loaded with sensors that let them know when there is something in front or behind them. They are also equipped with microphones that can hear sound (and even detect where that sound is coming from) and infrared sensors that let them see and communicate with other robots. Students work in teams to complete fun missions and master the robots’ capabilities.

#### **Grades Pre-K & K – Sing Me a Story**

In this creative music class, young musicians express themselves by acting out stories and writing original songs. Through theatre games and improvisation, they'll learn some basic tools of scene writing and songwriting. After playing out a few well-known stories, they'll work together to create their own original story – and write their own all-original musical play! The young musicians will then rehearse the piece they have written and perform it in the Wingspan Arts showcase.

#### **Grades K-1 – Art Explorers**

Students will cut, paint, glue, draw, and sculpt! This class will focus on the individuality and creative thinking process of each child as images and three-dimensional forms emerge from stories, poetry, and free association. Concepts will come to life as students develop skills to communicate their ideas in unique ways. This is a great class to explore a variety of artistic mediums.

#### **Grades 1-3 – Dance Studio**

Dancers in this class will experience the joy of expression through different forms of dance. Students will be introduced to tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, as well as the historical influence these dance styles have had in the movement world. Dance terminology, core strength, balance, and imagination will drive this class to a creative dance performance at the end of the semester.

#### **Grades 2-4 – Studio Art**

This class is designed for students who want to develop and refine their artistic vision. Surrounded by other young sculptors, painters, and illustrators – we will work toward an understanding of each artist's voice. This class is for young artists who want to experiment and develop skills with new and familiar mediums!

#### **Grades 3-5 Circus Arts**

Structured silliness is the order of the day as students use clowning, juggling, and tumbling to express their inner goofball! Commedia dell'arte mask work puts comedy in historical perspective, while juggling improves hand-eye coordination. Every student will develop their own clown, a unique and personal expression of their sense of humor, and work together in team-building activities to culminate in one crazy adventure!

### Wednesday

#### Grades Pre-K & K – Yogamotion

Breathe deeply. Meditate. Stretch. Move! Through the ancient art of yoga, students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. These yoga sessions will combine emotional reflection, light stretching, breathing, various yoga poses, and meditation. Students will learn downward facing dog, upward facing dog, child's pose, windmill pose, frog pose, tortoise pose and more! By the end of the semester, students will feel peaceful sharing all they've learned in a yoga demonstration. Namaste.

#### Grades K-1 – Dance Me a Story

Dance is one of the most graceful and exciting ways to tell a story. The students in this class will use stories to inspire choreography. Blending the exciting elements of plot, music dynamics, and movement, students in this class will integrate their learning into a spectacular visual story. Watch them skip, bop, and shimmy their way from "Once Upon a Time" to "Happily Ever After"!

#### Grades 1-5 – Tae Kwon Do \*\$25 Insurance Fee

In Taekwondo, students will get exercise, learn self-defense, and have a ton of fun! While developing skills in self-control, respect, and integrity, students will engage in safe activities highlighting the importance of perseverance. Every class will focus on the characteristics of a martial artist and demonstrate them through physical activities such as agility drills, kicking, and basic self-defense techniques. Students will gain confidence and focus, as well as a strong camaraderie with their classmates.

#### Grades 2-4 – Dance Expressions

Dancers in this class will experience the joy of expression through different forms of dance. Students will be introduced to tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, as well as the historical influence these dance styles have had in the movement world. Dance terminology, core strength, balance, and imagination will drive this class to a creative dance performance at the end of the semester.

#### Grades 3-5 – Art Studio: Drawing & Painting

Create sketch drawings and turn them into beautiful paintings using a variety of paints and canvases! Learn how to use color and value to create light, shadows, and form. Explore composition, color mixing, painting techniques, and self-expression in this fun class!

#### Grades Pre-K & K – Fairytale Theatre

Fairies and goblins and elves, oh my! Students will combine storytelling with theatre and let their imaginations soar in this creative drama class. Young artists will explore classic fairytales and bring them to the stage each week. They will also create their own and bring new characters to life! This class will culminate in the performance of a fairytale!

#### Grades K-1 – Spanish Adventures with Lango \*\$15 Additional Fee

This class combines songs, movement, art and crafts, and language activities to create a Spanish-learning experience unlike any other. This class is designed to foster an interest in foreign languages and cultures, as well as promote the development of a child's linguistic abilities. In addition to learning basic vocabulary words and phrases (e.g. colors, numbers, animals, etc.), all afterschool students will read a book from our signature Lango Kids series. These books follow the Lango Kids--Wen, Luc, and Lucia,--their teacher, and Cosmo the dog on their various adventures throughout the Spanish-speaking world. Each story focuses on a specific set of specialized vocabulary and usually contains a sweet and simple moral.

#### Grades 1-3 – Mini-Musical

"5, 6, 7, 8!" Learn a dance, sing a song, and perform a monologue in this introductory musical theatre class. Students will learn what it takes to become a triple threat, while also being introduced to many Broadway musicals. Students will work as an ensemble to create their own original musical focusing on the story structure of major Broadway musicals.

#### Grades 2-4 – Giant Puppets

Designers in this class will create their own puppets and bring them to life! This class will give students a chance to build puppets from lollipops, styrofoam balls, vegetables and fruit, pop-up paper, and more! Every puppeteer will create unique characters with their puppets before taking them home! The class culminates in a puppetry show or gallery at the end of the semester!

#### Grades 3-5 – Street Music

Students will feel the beat in this exciting introductory percussion class. Using tempo, rhythm, and tone, students will learn basic percussion techniques and how to create dynamic music using found objects such as trashcans, buckets, and paint cans. The semester will culminate in a final music performance featuring the student ensemble in a percussion jam.

#### **Grades Pre-K & K – Dance Around the World**

In this class, dancers will learn styles such as African, jazz, ballet, salsa, Afro-Caribbean, Indian, hip hop, funk and swing. They will dance to music from all over the world and participate in games and exercises that will help them listen to the sounds that make each style and culture unique. This class encourages an awareness and appreciation of other countries' historical dance styles and inspires students to find a common colorful thread that runs through ALL movement.

#### **Grades K-1 – Lego Masters \*\$15 Materials Fee**

Learn how to become Lego-smart! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all through the fun of Legos. Students will build towns, spaceships, bridges, railroads, artwork, and a whole lot more in this exciting class!

#### **Grades 1-5 – Karate with KP for Kids \*\$40 Insurance Fee, \$30 Uniform fee for new students**

KP for Kids is a professional karate afterschool program staffed with well-trained instructors that demonstrate respectful behavior in an active, physical, fun-loving environment. It is KP's philosophy that all children must be treated respectfully in order to emulate that behavior towards others. Additionally, children should have access to a safe, healthy, encouraging afterschool activity that will help develop not only their physical abilities, but also their mental focus and concentration. KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities.

#### **Grades 3-5 – Rock Band \*\$40 Materials Fee**

We will, we will ROCK you! In this class, students will develop a look, a style, and a sound that's totally new and fresh. They will work with professional rock musicians and put together a set of totally original music. With the classic instruments of guitar, drums, bass, and keyboard - students will learn what it really takes to make a rock band. All students will be rockin' the house by the end of the semester.
