


### About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 130, and work in partnership with PS 130 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

### A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan’s central meeting area at PS 130.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM.
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00 PM.
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00 PM. Students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00 PM; a fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6 PM; fee increases after third late pick-up. *\*Consistent early pick-ups (before 5:00 PM) will not be accommodated.*

### Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

### Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. ### Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

# Class Descriptions

## Fall 2019

### MONDAY

#### **Grades Pre-K & K – Come Tell a Story with *Spellbound Theatre* \* \$60 Materials Fee**

In this fun-filled creative drama class students will explore different stories and then get a chance to make up their own! In each session the drama experience will extend into an art activity which will help us visualize our ideas. Through storytelling and imaginative play, students will develop their creativity, confidence, and collaborative skills while crafting a final project together.

#### **Grades K - 1 - Lego Creations\* \$15 Materials Fee**

Legos just got even *more* fun! In this class, students will experience the excitement and creativity of Legos and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills while using creativity and imagination to build the most amazing creations!

#### **Grade 1 – Broadway Bound**

This class is for future Broadway stars. Performers will learn what it takes to put together a show from start to finish, complete with acting, singing and dancing. Students will learn and create choreography, practice monologues and scenes, and develop their own song book! For those who are interested in learning more about musical theatre, this class will cover everything an actor needs to know to become Broadway bound!

### TUESDAY

#### **Grades Pre-K & K - Musical Yoga with *Yo Re Mi* \* \$15 Materials Fee**

Yo Re Mi is a music, movement, and mindfulness program for children and families. In each fun-filled session, we use our bodies, voices, and imaginations. Through Yo Re Mi's unique integration of yoga-based movement and original live music, we collaboratively explore nature, geography, culture, language, rhythm, dance, songwriting and playing instruments.

#### **Grades K - 1 – Actor's Playground**

Ever wondered why they call it a play? Because acting is fun! In this play-based drama class, students will experiment with improvisation, ensemble-building, and acting exercises to discover the joy of theatre. Using familiar stories, students will create theatrical worlds to learn about character, relationships, and conflict. All the world's a stage (or a playground) in this energetic and active thespian experience.

#### **Grade 1- Crayola Passport with *Mad Science* \*\$60 Materials Fee**

Embark on an around-the-world cultural adventure – explore far-off places and learn about the people who live there, from the Americas to Polynesia, from the cosmopolitan to the countryside. Experiment with Crayola® products, while trying art techniques developed by local artists and artisans. Make different

masterpieces each week such as drums, masks, canvases, prints, buses, and more! Bring the unique creations home and build a globally-inspired art gallery.

### **WEDNESDAY**

#### **Grades Pre-K & K – Art Explorers**

Students will cut, paint, glue, draw, and sculpt! This class will focus on the individuality and creative thinking process of each child as images and three-dimensional forms emerge from stories, poetry, and free association. Concepts will come to life as students develop skills to communicate their ideas in unique ways. This is a great class to explore a variety of artistic mediums.

#### **Grades K - 1 - Dance Studio**

Dancers in this class will experience the joy of expression through different forms of dance. Students will be introduced to tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, as well as the historical influence these dance styles have had in the movement world. Dance terminology, core strength, balance, and imagination will drive this class to a creative dance performance at the end of the semester.

#### **Grade 1 - Lego Masters\* \$15 Materials Fee**

Learn how to become Lego-smart! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all through the fun of Legos. Students will build towns, spaceships, bridges, railroads, artwork, and a whole lot more in this exciting class!

### **THURSDAY**

#### **Grades Pre-K & K – Dance Me A Story**

Dance is one of the most graceful and exciting ways to tell a story. The students in this class will use stories to inspire choreography. Blending the exciting elements of plot, music dynamics, and movement, students in this class will integrate their learning into a spectacular visual story. Watch them skip, bop, and shimmy their way from “Once Upon a Time” to “Happily Ever After”!

#### **Grades K - 1 – Puppets & Play**

Puppeteers will design, build, and activate their puppets in this hands-on and creative class. This class will give students a chance to research the mechanics and engineering of puppet design, while also using their imaginations to create new characters! Students will build puppets from lollipops, styrofoam balls, vegetables and fruit, and pop-up paper, and then bring them to life through acting exercises and techniques. The class culminates in a puppetry performance at the end of the semester!

Through songs, games, and exercises, students will learn the fundamentals of music. Students will explore dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm - all while learning to sing and play their favorite songs. Musicians in this class will write and perform songs while gaining a basic knowledge of music theory and vocabulary.

### **FRIDAY**

#### **Grades Pre-K & K – Music To Your Ears with Music To Your Home** \*\$15 Materials Fee

Singers will develop proper vocal technique in this introductory music class. Through songs, games, and exercises, students will explore the fundamentals of vocal performance, and the joy that singing brings! Students will sing, move, and enjoy listening to music that ranges from Tchaikovsky to Frank Sinatra, and even some of Broadway's top hits! By the end of the semester, each student will use their understanding of music composition to sing their hearts out in an original performance.

#### **Grades K - 1 – Toymakers Workshop** \*\$15 Materials Fee

Have you ever wondered how they make your favorite toys? Let's find out! In this hands-on class, students will learn the science and engineering behind how toys work. Students will create and design their own toys and develop new ways to play. This visual arts class combines imagination and curiosity, and the students will take home many handmade toys.

#### **Grade 1 – Acting & Improv**

Students will learn the skills of Acting and Improvisation in this hands-on, spontaneous theatre class. Actors will learn the basic rules of improv to develop and hone their skills as performers. They will learn to SAY YES and "roll with it" through their exploration of acting techniques, games, and exercises. Students will create exciting characters, conflicts, and stories by using their voices, bodies, and imaginations. The class will culminate in an improv performance for all to enjoy!
