Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 267, and work in partnership with PS 267 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan's central meeting area at PS 267.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM.
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 5:00 PM
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 5:50 PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 5:50 PM; a fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 5:50 PM; fee increases after third late pick-up. *Consistent early pick-ups (before 5:00 PM) will not be accommodated.

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Refund Policy

Class Descriptions Fall 2019

MONDAY

Grades K - 1 - Actor's Playground

Ever wondered why they call it a play? Because acting is fun! In this play-based drama class, students will experiment with improvisation, ensemble-building, and acting exercises to discover the joy of theatre. Using familiar stories, students will create theatrical worlds to learn about character, relationships, and conflict. All the world's a stage (or a playground) in this energetic and active thespian experience.

Grades K - 1 - Art Explorers

Students will cut, paint, glue, draw, and sculpt! This class will focus on the individuality and creative thinking process of each child as images and three-dimensional forms emerge from stories, poetry, and free association. Concepts will come to life as students develop skills to communicate their ideas in unique ways. This is a great class to explore a variety of artistic mediums.

Grades 2 - 3 - Singing Sensations

Become your favorite pop star! From Taylor Swift to Bruno Mars, students will learn to sing and dance like these amazing pop stars - and even create their own performing personalities. Each week students will work on the vocal skills, dance moves, and personal style it takes to become a superstar!

Grades 3 - 5 - Rocket Science: Destination Mars \$60 Materials Fee

Join our flight crew as we blast off to Mars! This exciting class is all about rockets and how they are fueling our knowledge of other worlds. Mission preparation includes building mini launch vehicles and conducting experiments to explore the science behind space travel. From the basics of Newton's Laws to solid and liquid propellants, students learn what it takes to be a real rocket scientist! The journey continues with a touchdown on the red planet where we establish a colony, build a rover, and orbit a satellite to explore the Martian landscape. It's sure to be an experience that's out of this world!



Class Descriptions Fall 2019

TUESDAY

Grades K - 1 - Sing Me a Story

In this creative music class, young musicians express themselves by acting out stories and writing original songs. Through theatre games and improvisation, they'll learn some basic tools of scene writing and songwriting. After playing out a few well-known stories, they'll work together to create their own original story – and write their own all-original musical play! The young musicians will then rehearse the piece they have written and perform it in the Wingspan Arts showcase.

Grades K - 1 - Puppets & Play

Puppeteers will design, build, and activate their puppets in this hands-on and creative class. This class will give students a chance to research the mechanics and engineering of puppet design, while also using their imaginations to create new characters! Students will build puppets from lollipops, styrofoam balls, vegetables and fruit, and pop-up paper, and then bring them to life through acting exercises and techniques. The class culminates in a puppetry performance at the end of the semester!

Grades 2 - 3 - Hip Hop

With a combination of old school and new school hip hop, dancers will learn cutting edge street dance movements. Students will pop, lock, jam, and break while also working together to create dynamic dance pieces. Balancing challenging choreography with the students' own creative influence, this class will result in an exciting dance performance.

Grades 3 - 5 - Cooking Creations with Allergic to Salad* \$25 Materials Fee

Fun, hands-on, and from-scratch! Our classes create a platform for a lifetime of adventurous eating and purposeful life-skills. Classes focus on kitchen safety, knife skills, and vegetable, fruit, and equipment identification. All classes include basic STEM concepts within the cooking lessons. Kids will be cooking up-- and eating-- dishes like spanikopita, sushi, paratha, pumpkin ravioli, and more!

WEDNESDAY

Grades K - 1 - Fairytale Theatre

Fairies and goblins and elves, oh my! Students will combine storytelling with theatre and let their imaginations soar in this creative drama class. Young artists will explore classic fairytales and bring them to the stage each week. They will also create a their own and bring new characters to life! This class will culminate in the performance of a fairytale!

Grades K to 1 - Toymaker's Workshop* \$15 Materials Fee

Have you ever wondered how they make your favorite toys? Let's find out! In this hands-on class, students will learn the science and engineering behind how toys work. Students will create and design their own toys and develop new ways to play. This visual arts class combines imagination and curiosity, and the students will take home many handmade toys.

Grades 2 - 3 - Mini-Musical

"5, 6, 7, 8!" Learn a dance, sing a song, and perform a monologue in this introductory musical theatre class. Students will learn what it takes to become a triple threat, while also being introduced to many Broadway musicals. Students will work as an ensemble to create their own original musical focusing on the story structure of major Broadway musicals.

Grades 3 - 5 - Mixed Media Arts

Mixed Media Arts uses an array of materials to emphasize creativity, invention, and fun! Projects include sculpture (clay, foam, paper, wire); carving (linoleum, potatoes, soap), mobile and collage work. Each week, students will learn about a famous artist while studying technique, craft, media, and art history. Using this knowledge, students will then create projects inspired by these artists.

THURSDAY

Grades K - 1 - Music to My Ears

Singers will develop proper vocal technique in this introductory music class. Through songs, games, and exercises, students will explore the fundamentals of vocal performance, and the joy that singing brings! Students will sing, move, and enjoy listening to music that ranges from Tchaikovsky to Frank Sinatra, and even some of Broadway's top hits! By the end of the semester, each student will use their understanding of music composition to sing their hearts out in an original performance.

Grades K - 1 - Lego Masters*\$15 Materials Fee

Learn how to become Lego-smart! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all through the fun of Legos. Students will build towns, spaceships, bridges, railroads, artwork, and a whole lot more in this exciting class!

Grades K to 5th - Karate with KP for Kids* \$40 Insurance Fee, \$30 Uniform Fee

KP for Kids is a professional karate afterschool program staffed with well-trained instructors that demonstrate respectful behavior in an active, physical, fun-loving environment. It is KP's philosophy that all children must be treated respectfully in order to emulate that behavior towards others. Additionally, children should have access to a safe, healthy, encouraging afterschool activity that will help develop not only their physical abilities, but also their mental focus and concentration. KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities.

Grades 3 - 5 - Sketch Comedy

Writers, comedians, and performers will master the art of funny in the Sketch Comedy class. Through writing exercises, improv games, and acting techniques, students will learn the fundamentals of comedy in performance. Students will create characters, conflicts, and circumstances that put the FUN in FUNNY! This class will culminate in a series of written sketches to be performed in front of a live audience!

FRIDAY

Grades K - 1 - Jewelry Making \$15 Materials Fee

In this class, students will make fashionable jewelry and clothing to wear! Some projects may include coiled wire rings, beading, clay bead making, stone wrapping, and brass hammering. Students will also learn basic sewing and do-it-yourself fashion, starting with drawing their own designs. Students will learn basic stitches, ways to sew without using a machine, and how to cut a basic pattern. Culminating projects will include revamping old t-shirts and jazzing up accessories such as belts, shoelaces, and headbands. Get ready for a fashion show or catalogue at the end of the semester!

Grades K - 1 - Movin' & Groovin'

This high-energy class combines rhythm and dance to get everyone movin' to the beat! Students will explore different dance and movement styles through a wide-range of fun music, imaginative games, and exercises. Students will focus on balance, rhythm, and technique on their creative search to find new ways to move to the groove!

Grades 2 - 3 - Art of Comics

Visualize your name on the cover of a handmade book! In this class, students will use tactile materials and a wide-array of artistic processes to create their own original works. Get ready to draw, paint, and cartoon while also creating adventurous and daring new stories! All artists will have the opportunity to turn their preliminary sketches into colorful characters as they create their own original comic strip!

Grades 3 - 5 - Pop Choir

Students will become "pitch perfect" by joining the vocal ensemble in Pop Choir. Singers will learn about melodies, harmonies, acapella, and solo performances while singing their favorite pop hits. Ariana Grande, Shawn Mendez, and Bruno Mars are just some of the musical influences inspiring the singers in this class. Students will perform their greatest hits at the end of the semester!
