

About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at PS 303, and work in partnership with PS 303 to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan’s central meeting area at PS 303.
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30 PM Monday-Thursday and 3 PM on Fridays
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5 PM Monday-Thursday and 3 - 4:30 PM on Fridays.
- Pick-up runs from 5 - 6 PM Monday-Thursday and 4:40 - 6 PM on Fridays; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6 PM; a fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6 PM; fee increases after third late pick-up. **Consistent early pick-ups (before 5 PM Monday-Thursday, before 4:40 PM on Fridays) will not be accommodated.*

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

Class Descriptions

Fall 2019

MONDAY

Grade Pre-K – Music Makers

Through songs, games, and exercises, students will learn the fundamentals of music. Students will explore dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm - all while learning to sing and play their favorite songs. Musicians in this class will write and perform songs while gaining a basic knowledge of music theory and vocabulary.

Grade K – Puzzles & Games *\$15 Materials Fee

This class will “Boggle” your mind! Learn from the classics, and create your own in this creative visual arts and play class. Play board and brain games, create new rules, and identify different types of puzzles - and then make your own! Design and build new games, treasure maps, puzzles, and mazes using classic visual arts techniques! You won't be “Sorry” you signed up for this class.

Grades K-1 – Actor’s Toolkit

In Actor’s Toolkit, students will build their skills in imaginative storytelling and improvisation. Through theatre games and ensemble-building exercises, the actors in this class will learn about character development, plot structure, and scene study. Students will use their actor tools of body, voice, and imagination to tell stories in a creative and expressive way. The actors will develop their emotional awareness and social skills, while also building their toolkit to become great performers!

Grades 1-2 – Yoga

Breathe deeply. Meditate. Stretch. Move! Through the ancient art of yoga, students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. These yoga sessions will combine emotional reflection, light stretching, breathing, various yoga poses, and meditation. Students will learn downward facing dog, upward facing dog, child’s pose, windmill pose, frog pose, tortoise pose and more! By the end of the semester, students will feel peaceful sharing all they’ve learned in a yoga demonstration. Namaste.

Grades 2-3 – Art Studio

This class is designed for students who want to develop and refine their artistic vision. Surrounded by other young sculptors, painters, and illustrators – students will work toward an understanding of each artist’s voice. This class is for young artists who want to experiment and develop skills with new and familiar mediums!

Grades 3-4 – Mini Musical

“5, 6, 7, 8!” Learn a dance, sing a song, and perform a monologue in this introductory musical theatre class. Students will learn what it takes to become a triple threat, while also being introduced to many Broadway musicals. Students will work as an ensemble to create their own original musical focusing on the story structure of major Broadway musicals.

TUESDAY

Grade Pre-K – Movin' & Groovin'

This high-energy class combines rhythm and dance to get everyone movin' to the beat! Students will explore different dance and movement styles through a wide-range of fun music, imaginative games, and exercises. Students will focus on balance, rhythm, and technique on their creative search to find new ways to move to the groove!

Grade K – Art Explorers

Students will cut, paint, glue, draw, and sculpt! This class will focus on the individuality and creative thinking process of each child as images and three-dimensional forms emerge from stories, poetry, and free association. Concepts will come to life as students develop skills to communicate their ideas in unique ways. This is a great class to explore a variety of artistic mediums.

Grades K-1 – Music to My Ears

Singers will develop proper vocal technique in this introductory music class. Through songs, games, and exercises, students will explore the fundamentals of vocal performance, and the joy that singing brings! Students will sing, move, and enjoy listening to music that ranges from Tchaikovsky to Frank Sinatra, and even some of Broadway's top hits! By the end of the semester, each student will use their understanding of music composition to sing their hearts out in an original performance.

Grades 1-2 – Future Choreographers

Students will be introduced to creative movement styles, as well as the value of a great choreographer! Dancers in this class will experience dance styles such as jazz, ballet, hip hop, funk, and swing, and then generate their own choreography. With a focus on leadership, ensemble-work, and creativity, this class will result in students choreographing their own unique dance performances.

Grades 2-3 – Shakespeare Players

Friends, Romans, Countrymen! Lend me your talents! The stories of Shakespeare have excited and moved people for centuries. Students will dive into his world of magic, dreams, and fantastic creatures! This class will weave acting exercises and literary games to increase students' comprehension of classical theatre and texts. Through verse, poetry, and humor, students will explore the thrill of Shakespeare's works while rehearsing one or more of his exciting plays. The group of students will form a troupe of Players and perform abridged works of the Bard. The play is the thing!

Grades 3-4 – DIY Publishing

Write your own book, create your own poster, publish a Wingspan Arts magazine in this exciting DIY Publishing class. Students will fuse their literary and creative talents to create an array of artistic projects. Students will create and produce their very own works in this publishing course!

WEDNESDAY

Grade Pre-K – Lego Artists *\$15 Materials Fee

In this class, students experience the excitement of Lego and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills while students use their imaginations to build artistic Lego creations! Students will learn about famous pieces of art and architecture, explore 2D mosaics, and build upwards in 3D. Students will be able to build individually and in groups, giving them a sense of ensemble and how their pieces and fun ideas fit into the whole.

Grade K – Page to Stage

Students will let their imaginations soar by combining storytelling with theatre! Students will hear classic and contemporary children's stories, and then they'll get a chance to create their own unique characters and plots! Through theatre games, acting exercises, and imaginative play, students will learn to bring the page to the stage in this literary performance class.

Grades K-1 – Art of Nature

In this class students will learn how to reduce, reuse, and reinvent! Projects will not only center on using both found objects and recycled materials, but also on utilizing natural materials. Find out not only how to save the earth, but make it beautiful!

Grades 1-2 – Global Theatre

Through different cultures' stories, celebrations, and traditions, students will bring the world to their classroom. Students will explore life and school from children around the world, focusing on cultural diversity and understanding. The performers in this class will dance, play, and sing their way around the world!

Grades 2-3 –Edible Art *\$25 Materials Fee

Students will create art inspired by and using fresh foods and organic materials! Paint with yogurt, create stamps out of broccoli and oranges, and build pasta portraits! This is a chance for students to play with their food and create pieces of art! By the end of the semester, students will create an art gallery and recipe book with their edible/ organic art.

Grades 3-4 –Modern Music

Through songs, games and exercises, students will explore the fundamentals of music and composition. Dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat and rhythm will be the focus of this exciting music composition class. The musicians will learn about different instruments and develop skills in songwriting while looking at popular songs in modern day music. Students will learn singing techniques, build their knowledge of music theory and terminology, and create their own sounds in Modern Music.

THURSDAY

Grade Pre-K – Fairytale Theatre

Fairies and goblins and elves, oh my! Students will combine storytelling with theatre and let their imaginations soar in this creative drama class. Young artists will explore classic fairytales and bring them to the stage each week. They will also create their own and bring new characters to life! This class will culminate in the performance of a fairytale!

Grade K – Yogamotion

Breathe deeply. Meditate. Stretch. Move! In this class students will gain flexibility and have the freedom to dance and explore creative movement. While being introduced to yoga, students will learn different poses and ways to move around. This class will explore finding moments of calm and fun in this active class. By the end of the semester, students will feel peaceful sharing all they've learned in a yoga demonstration. Namaste.

Grades K-1 – Dance Studio

Dancers in this class will experience the joy of expression through different forms of dance. Students will be introduced to tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, as well as the historical influence these dance styles have had in the movement world. Dance terminology, core strength, balance, and imagination will drive this class to a creative dance performance at the end of the semester.

Grades 1-2 – Star Performers

Through the exploration of song and dance, students will become Star Performers! From Ariana Grande to Justin Timberlake, performers will learn to sing and dance like these amazing pop stars! Each week students will work on the vocal techniques, choreography, and personal style it takes to become a super star! At the end of the semester, the Star Performers will dazzle in a pop concert performance!

Grades 2-3 – Mixed Media Arts

Mixed Media Arts uses an array of materials to emphasize creativity, invention, and fun! Projects include sculpture (clay, foam, paper, wire); carving (linoleum, potatoes, soap), mobile and collage work. Each week, students will learn about a famous artist while studying technique, craft, media, and art history. Using this knowledge, students will then create projects inspired by these artists.

Grades 3-4 – Improv Workshop

Students will learn the skills of Acting and Improvisation in this hands-on, spontaneous theatre class. Actors will learn the basic rules of improv to develop and hone their skills as performers. They will learn to SAY YES and "roll with it" through their exploration of acting techniques, games, and exercises. Students will create exciting characters, conflicts, and stories by using their voices, bodies, and imaginations. The class will culminate in an improv performance for all to enjoy!

FRIDAY

Grade Pre-K – Painter’s Palette

Create sketch drawings and turn them into beautiful paintings using a variety of paints and canvases! Learn how to use color and value to create light, shadows, and form. Explore composition, color mixing, painting techniques, and self-expression in this fun class!

Grade K – Sing Me A Story

In this creative music class, young musicians express themselves by acting out stories and writing original songs. Through theatre games and improvisation, they’ll learn some basic tools of scene writing and songwriting. After playing out a few well-known stories, they’ll work together to create their own original story – and write their own all-original musical play! The young musicians will then rehearse the piece they have written and perform it in the Wingspan Arts showcase.

Grades K-1 – Lego Architects *\$15 Materials Fee

Learn how to become Lego-smart! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all through the fun of Legos. Students will build towns, spaceships, bridges, railroads, artwork, and a whole lot more in this exciting class!

Grades 1-2 – 3D Artists

Let’s build! This class is a 3D visual arts class with an emphasis on creativity, fun, and invention! Students will learn sculpture methods using clay, foam, wire, and more. Through pottery, ceramics, statues, and abstract sculpture - students will learn the different techniques necessary to become a true 3D Artist.

Grades 2-3 – Hip Hop

With a combination of old school and new school hip hop, dancers will learn cutting edge street dance movements. Students will pop, lock, jam, and break while also working together to create dynamic dance pieces. Balancing challenging choreography with the students’ own creative influence, this class will result in an exciting dance performance.

Grades 3-4 – Art of Science *\$15 Materials Fee

In Art of Science, students explore science creatively by using their right brain and all of their senses. They’ll taste the periodic table and discover the science of music. Students will explore the solar system, space, and even dinosaurs through dance, theatre games, and puppetry. They will paint, color, and craft experiments that help them understand friction, force, chemical reactions, and so much more! This class is perfect for the creative and the curious.
