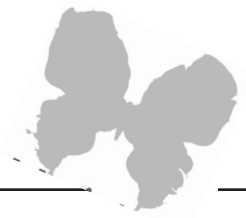

About Wingspan Arts

Wingspan Arts is a non-profit organization that is fully insured and professionally managed. We hold our programs ON-SITE at YCS, and work in partnership with YCS to offer semester-long afterschool arts enrichment classes that meet once a week. The program is staffed by Site Director(s), Site Assistant(s), and professional Teaching Artists.

A Day at Wingspan Arts

- When students are dismissed from school, they are escorted to Wingspan’s central meeting area at YCS
- Students are provided with a snack and an option of arts based activities from school dismissal until 3:30PM
- Arts enrichment classes run for 90 minutes from 3:30 - 5:00 PM
- Pick-up runs from 5:00 - 6:00 PM; students again participate in a choice of arts based activities, other supervised games, or homework.
- Pick-up ends promptly at 6:00 PM; a fee of \$1/minute will be charged for any students remaining after 6 PM; fee increases after third late pick-up. **Consistent early pick-ups (before 5:00 PM) will not be accommodated.*

Tax Information

Our afterschool programs may be claimed as a childcare expense on your taxes, or used with a flex spending account! Our Federal Tax ID is 13-4189808, and our office can provide you with a formal receipt.

Financial Aid

Wingspan Arts has a long tradition of providing need-based financial aid to our incredible afterschool communities. We do our best to ensure that every child has access to the arts, regardless of their ability to pay the full tuition for our programs. Refund Policy

- If your child is not satisfied with his/her afterschool class, and withdraws within the first two weeks, we offer a full credit to your Wingspan Arts account to be used for a future class or Half-Day program.
- After the first two weeks, we offer a pro-rated credit amount to your Wingspan Arts account.
- If you wish instead to be refunded to your credit card, Wingspan Arts charges a \$50 refund fee.

Class Descriptions

Monday

Grades Pre-K & K – Lego Creations *\$15 Materials Fee

Legos just got even *more* fun! In this class, students will experience the excitement and creativity of Legos and learning! This class will introduce teamwork, observation, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills all while using creativity and imagination to build the most amazing creations imaginable!

Grades Pre-K & K – Music Makers

Through songs, games, and exercises, students will learn the fundamentals of music. Students will explore dynamics, tempo, pitch, melody, beat, and rhythm - all while learning to sing and play their favorite songs. Musicians in this class will write and perform songs while gaining a basic knowledge of music theory and vocabulary.

Grades 1-2 – Art of Comics

Visualize your name on the cover of a handmade book! In this class, students will use tactile materials and a wide-array of artistic processes to create their own original works. Get ready to draw, paint, and cartoon while also creating adventurous and daring new stories! All artists will have the opportunity to turn their preliminary sketches into colorful characters as they create their own original comic strip!

Grades 1-3 – Mini Musical

“5, 6, 7, 8!” Learn a dance, sing a song, and perform a monologue in this introductory musical theatre class. Students will learn what it takes to become a triple threat, while also being introduced to many Broadway musicals. Students will work as an ensemble to create their own original musical focusing on the story structure of major Broadway musicals.

Grades 3-5 – 3D Artists

Let's build! This class is a 3D visual arts class with an emphasis on creativity, fun, and invention! Students will learn sculpture methods using clay, foam, wire, and more. Through pottery, ceramics, statues, and abstract sculpture - students will learn the different techniques necessary to become a true 3D Artist.

Grades Pre-K & K – Jr. Asphalt Jungle

This energetic class will be having tons of fun in the schoolyard. Get ready for four square, stickball, chalk games, and many more as we explore the most popular games on the playground! And not just recent games – we'll explore games from days past, and have a "ball"!

Grades Pre-K & K – Fairytale Theatre

Fairies and goblins and elves, oh my! Combining storytelling with theatre, this creative drama class fosters every student's imagination. Students will explore classic fairytales and might even create a few tales of their own, bringing new characters to life on the stage! This is the perfect class for aspiring actors, playwrights, or students who just love the magic and mystery of fairytales.

Grades 1-2 – Star Performers

Become your favorite pop star! From Taylor Swift to Bruno Mars, students will learn to sing and dance like these amazing pop stars - and even create their own performing personalities. Each week students will work on the vocal skills, dance moves, and personal style it takes to become a super star!

Grades 1-3 – Modern Masters

This class is for the artist and the art historian alike! In this class, students will learn about and discuss different art genres and periods, such as Impressionism, Fauvism, Pointillism, Art Nouveau, Art Deco, Pop Art, and abstract art. They will then create their own 2D and 3D artworks inspired by these ideas. Students will also create relationships with the artists of history, and develop their own techniques to find their authentic artist self.

Grades 3-5 – Dance Studio

Dancers in this class will experience the joy of expression through different forms of dance. Students will be introduced to tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, step, funk, and swing, as well as the historical influence these dance styles have had in the movement world. Dance terminology, core strength, balance, and imagination will drive this class to a creative dance performance at the end of the semester.

Wednesday

Grades Pre-K & K – Movin' and Groovin'

This high-energy class combines rhythm and dance to get everyone movin' to the beat! Students will explore different dance and movement styles through a wide-range of fun music, imaginative games, and exercises. Students will focus on balance, rhythm, and technique on their creative search to find new ways to move to the groove!

Grades Pre-K & K – Art Explorers

Students will cut, paint, glue, draw, and sculpt! This class will focus on the individuality and creative thinking process of each child as images and three-dimensional forms emerge from stories, poetry, and free association. Concepts will come to life as students develop skills to communicate their ideas in unique ways. This is a great class to explore a variety of artistic mediums.

Grades 1-2 – Actor's Workshop

Calling all actors! In Actor's Workshop, students will learn key elements of theatre performance and rehearsal practices. Through monologue and scene study, as well as in-depth character development exercises, the actors in this class will learn the value of objectives, tactics, and stakes in performance. Students will also have the opportunity to develop their own pieces, and direct their fellow classmates. At the end of the semester, the actors will show off what they've learned in a short play!

Grades 1-3 – Freaky Forces & Elusive Energies with Launch *\$60 Materials Fee

May the forces of physics be with you! From the magic of magnetism to the science of sound, our physicists-in-training explore a world filled with energies and forces! Exciting projects such as lava lamps, clay boats, catapults and color spinners allow children to touch, feel, and see the complex concepts that are the building blocks of physics. The energy (potential and kinetic!) in the class is contagious as kids are introduced to intriguing topics ranging from buoyancy and displacement to trajectories and projectile motion. And to continue the inspirational learning beyond class, kids keep all of their creations for further exploration at home!

Grades 3-5 – Songwriting

Students will examine the craft of songwriting through the use of poetry, percussion, and singing. Students will write songs both individually and as an ensemble, and each student will develop proper singing techniques and a core understanding of music vocabulary. By the end of the semester, students will write and perform their own original songs!

Thursday

Grades Pre-K & K – Canvas Creations

Van Gogh, Picasso, and Monet are only some of the names students will learn in this exciting hands-on class. Through the introduction of several painting techniques, students will learn about image composition, drawing, shadows, and light. With a variety of methods, students will learn about art history and also create their own pieces. Students will refine their fine motor skills and enjoy working with watercolor, acrylic, and pastels in this exciting art studio class.

Grades Pre-K & K – Sing Me a Story

In this creative music class, young musicians express themselves by acting out stories and writing original songs. Through theatre games and improvisation, they'll learn some basic tools of scene writing and songwriting. After playing out a few well-known stories, they'll work together to create their own original story – and write their own all-original musical play! The young musicians will then rehearse the piece they have written and perform it in the Wingspan Arts showcase.

Grades 1-5 – Karate with KP for Kids \$40 Insurance Fee

KP for Kids is a professional karate afterschool program staffed with well-trained instructors that demonstrate respectful behavior in an active, physical, fun-loving environment. It is KP's philosophy that all children must be treated respectfully in order to emulate that behavior towards others. Additionally, children should have access to a safe, healthy, encouraging after school activity that will help develop not only their physical abilities but also their mental focus and concentration. KP for Kids offers this in a goal oriented traditional belt karate program with the addition of incorporating healthy Pilates exercises to promote core strength for all activities. **If you are a new student, a \$30 Uniform Fee will also apply.**

Grades 1-3 – Playwriting

Playwrights in this class will bring their stories to the stage! Students will discover the excitement of playwriting as they bring plot, character, theme, and more to life in the limelight. After an introduction to the basics of dramatic theory and the playwriting process, students will have the opportunity to write and perform their own theatrical masterpiece!

Let's travel the world! From Italy to Japan, Egypt to Australia, students will explore art from across the globe. Students will paint, sculpt, and sketch their way through different folktales, celebrations, and traditions. Students will bring the world to their classroom!

Grades Pre-K & K - Musical Yoga with Yo Re Mi * \$15 Materials Fee

Yo Re Mi is a music, movement, and mindfulness program for children and families. In each fun-filled session, we use our bodies, voices, and imaginations. Through Yo Re Mi's unique integration of yoga-based movement and original live music, we collaboratively explore nature, geography, culture, language, rhythm, dance, songwriting and playing instruments.

Grades Pre-K & K – Actor's Playground

Ever wondered why they call it a play? Because acting is fun! In this play-based drama class, students will experiment with improvisation, ensemble-building, and acting exercises to discover the joy of theatre. Using familiar stories, students will create theatrical worlds to learn about character, relationships, and conflict. All the world's a stage (or a playground) in this energetic and active thespian experience.

Grades K-1 – Studio Art

This class is designed for students who want to develop and refine their artistic vision. Surrounded by other young sculptors, painters, and illustrators – students will work toward an understanding of each artist's voice. This class is for young artists who want to experiment and develop skills with new and familiar mediums!

Grades 1-3– Hip Hop

With a combination of old school and new school hip hop, dancers will learn cutting edge street dance movements. Students will pop, lock, jam, and break while also working together to create dynamic dance pieces. Balancing challenging choreography with the students' own creative influence, this class will result in an exciting dance performance.

Grades 3-5 – Improv Workshop

Students will learn the skills of Acting and Improvisation in this hands-on, spontaneous theatre class. Actors will learn the basic rules of improv to develop and hone their skills as performers. They will learn to SAY YES and "roll with it" through their exploration of acting techniques, games, and exercises. Students will create exciting characters, conflicts, and stories by using their voices, bodies, and imaginations. The class will culminate in an improv performance for all to enjoy!
